OLCC To Get Tough To Halt Violations

Portland — (U.P.) — The Oregon Liquor Control commission said Friday it planned to get tough to halt a rising volume of violations.

The OLCC emphasized its position by handing out a 45-day suspension to one grocery store accused of selling beer to a minor.

Hugh Kirkpatrick, OLCC chairman, said members viewed with grave concern an increasing number of violations. "The commission is going to put into effect more penalties and more severe penalties as violations occur," he said.

He said "it has come to our attention that grocery stores are not watching minors as they should."

The commission also announced a policy of no new liquor-by-the-drink outlets in the state except in cases of demonstrated "public need."
