### Injections by Spray Gun

Years ago, men working around diesel engines sometimes got hit by a small amount of oil that, under tremendous pressure, had squirted out from one of the cylinders. This oil would go right through their skin without making an obvious hole. Then men started trying to build a small "gun" which would shoot a drop of medicine or vaccine through a person's skin. Now after six years of study, an automatic injector is in an advanced stage of development. The inventors hope soon to have all the "bugs" out of it. There are at least two great advantages of such a "gun" especially in army work. One is that men can file by and get their shots in a matter of seconds; and the other is that syringes and needles will not have to be sterilized again and again. The gun now available can be cocked and reloaded in four or five seconds. Usually an injection with the gun causes less discomfort than does the barrage of a hypodermic needle.

## Traffic in Canal Reaches Normal

Cairo — The Suez canal traffic reached its normal level Saturday under Egyptian terms that all nations except France and Israel accepted. Informed sources said that Egypt considered the canal controversy a closed chapter of history. They said Egypt would reject any attempt by France to reopen the canal question before the United Nations Security Council. In this, the Egyptian regime had the backing of the Soviet Union. Egypt already had served notice that it intends to continue its nine-year-old blockade of Israeli shipping in the canal and will stop any Israeli ship sent to the waterway to test the ban. A total of 37 ships sailed into the canal Saturday in north and southbound convoys. For the first time since Egypt reopened the canal, the number equalled the daily average prior to last July when the waterway was nationalized.

## Zephyr Hits Slide, Derails in Canyon

Oroville, Calif. — The Western Pacific's Chicago-bound Zephyr hit a rock slide about 20 miles east of here Saturday and derailed in the Feather river canyon. There were no injuries, according to WP's dispatching office in Sacramento, which said it has been in "constant contact" with the train conductor, James Crowe. But two rescue parties have left here for the scene by special train and automobile. They include sheriff's deputies, doctors, nurses and volunteer workers.

## Ships Give Up Search In North Sea for Sub

London — British, Dutch and Swedish ships searching the North Sea have found no trace Saturday of a submarine which had been believed sunk about midway between Britain and the Northern Netherlands. The "flashing buoy," sighted Friday night by the Danish freighter, whose signals set off the search, also had vanished. It was believed to have sunk. The only "foreign object" found in the area was an anchored oil drum dropped by the Danish freighter Mary North to mark the approximate position of the mysterious buoy.
