Egypt Said Willing To Submit Question

Israel received reports from the United Nations Monday that Egypt is willing to submit the question of Israeli passage through the Suez Canal to international arbitration.

But the reports said Egypt would attach a number of conditions, including a promise that such actions would not amount to recognizing Israel and would not prejudice Egypt's position. The reports said the conditional acceptance of arbitration was given to UN Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjöld in New York by Egyptian delegate Omar Loufi.

Judge Ponders Attorney Selection in Roseburg

Roseburg—Circuit Judge Carl E. Wimberly has taken under advisement a claim challenging the right of attorney Avery Thompson to hold office as Douglas county district attorney.

Thompson, a Democrat, was named by Gov. Robert Holmes to the position vacated by Robert Stultz, a Republican. Attorney James Richmond challenged the right of Thompson to the office, claiming it should have gone to a Republican.

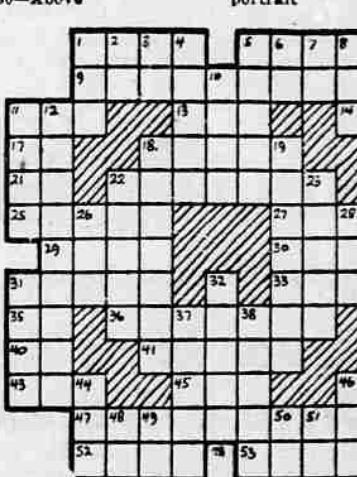
