New Light on Fluoridation

So many people have written to ask me where they could find a disinterested summary of the facts in regard to fluoridation that I am here calling attention to a book that has just come to my desk. "The Fight for Fluoridation."

It is written, not by a dentist or a physician, but by Donald R. McNeil, Associate Director of the Wisconsin State Historical Association. He has written a remarkable and gripping story, and has documented it well. Interesting to many readers will be the fact that the value of traces of fluorine in the drinking-water in hardening the surface of teeth was discovered in 1901, when Dr. Frederick S. McKay, a young dentist in Colorado Springs, became interested in the cause of the ugly, stained teeth of many persons in that community.

What so many persons do not know is that in several cities throughout the world there is so large an excess of fluorine in the water that the peoples' teeth become mottled. In these cities there is seven or 10 times the amount of fluorine in the water that health authorities today want to add (if their city water has no fluorine). And yet the people in the cities with a large amount of fluorine have had no health problems.

Mr. McNeil is not rabidly for or against fluoridation. After gathering thousands of facts from official sources, he thinks it is a good idea, and he can see no harm in it.

The Loss of Smell

People write to ask why they lost their sense of smell, but they don't tell me how old they are or whether the thing came suddenly. In older persons a loss

of smell that comes suddenly is probably due to a little stroke. A small blood vessel is plugged up in one of the tracts in the brain which has to deal with the sense of smell. Rarely, I have seen a loss of smell for a while in a person who became depressed or psychotic. Temporary brief losses of smell can, of course, be due to a cold. I know of no treatment for the condition.

Dr. Alvarez hopes his readers will understand that it would be impossible for him to answer requests for information or to attempt to diagnose by mail.
