

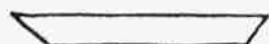

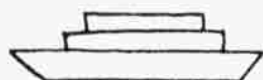

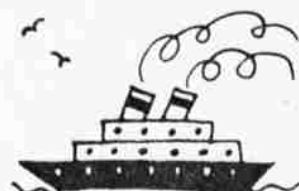
Draw a pie tin lying flat,
