Actor's Son Given County Jail Term

Santa Monica, Calif.—Actor Edward G. Robinson's 24-year-old son, Edward Jr., has been sentenced to 60 days in county jail and placed on three years probation for drunk driving.

Young Robinson was sentenced Monday on an April 18 conviction of misdemeanor drunk driving, growing out of a traffic accident in which a friend, Martin Barth, 37, lost the sight of an eye.

A plea that the young man be released on probation because he was undergoing treatment for alcoholism was denied by Superior Judge Allen T. Lynch.

He freely admitted attending the meeting himself. He faces a maximum penalty of one year in jail and a \$1000 fine.

French Premier's Chances Said Slim
