

Governor Signs Bill Authorizing Oregon Economic Department

Salem—Oregon acquired a new Department of Economic Development when Gov. Robert D. Holmes signed House Bill 445.

The measure will make it the business of the executive branch of state government to get into the nationwide contest for expansion and new industrial growth. The department was urged by Gov. Holmes in his inaugural address.

In signing the bill the governor said, "The Development Department won't perform immediate miracles, but it will unite every section of the state and every interest concerned with prosperity in an aggressive attempt to pull Oregon out of its economic rut."

Members of the old Oregon Development Commission will be asked to serve on a new advisory committee to help the new department.

Pending final selection of a director for the new department, Ivan Bloch and Associates will assist the state in a consulting capacity, the governor said.

Holmes has until tonight to complete his signing of all bills

under Oregon law.

Among bills signed yesterday were:

HB 345: Liberalizing absentee voting requirements.

HB 388 and 387: Changing the Corrupt Practices Act to provide for both pre-election and post-election reporting of campaign contributions and expenditures.

HB 397: Increasing district attorneys' salaries.

HB 418: Re-organizing the State Board of Forestry and setting up definite four-year terms for members.

HB 626: Licensing professional promoters or solicitors for charity by county courts.

HB 681: Broadening authority of the highway commission to construct certain signs.

HB 630: Appropriating money to the Natural Resources committee for stream and watershed studies.

HB 242: Permitting co-operative electrical systems to pay a 2 per cent gross earnings tax in lieu of ad valorem property taxes.

HB 267: Authorizing the superintendent of public instruction to refuse to issue teaching certificates to persons convicted of sex offenses.

54 Measles Cases Reported Last Week

Forty-two cases of measles were reported in Medford and Ashland to the Jackson county department of health for the week ending June 7, according to Dr. A. Erin Merkel, public health physician.

Cases of measles also were reported in Gold Hill nine, Shady Cove three, and Central Point one.

Fifteen other communicable diseases were reported in the county last week. Dr. Merkel said. They included German measles four, Medford three and Ashland; whooping cough two, Medford and Gold Hill; pneumonia one, Medford; tuberculosis one, Medford; infectious hepatitis one, Medford; chicken pox four, Medford two and Ashland two; impetigo one, Gold Hill; and infectious mononucleosis one, Medford.

Hollywood — A young New York designer who made Jayne Mansfield's neckline famous accuses Liberace and Elvis Presley of fouling up his campaign to get men into more interesting clothes.

"Liberace and Elvis have set men's fashions back 20 years," fumed Elgee Bovee, at 22 one of the country's top designers.

"When you try to get men to wear more interesting clothes they're afraid of appearing feminine. Liberace's frilly shirts with gobs of lace kill men's wear. He looks like a ruffled layer cake."

Bovee unveiled his first collection of clothes for men when he popped out here to arrange new wardrobes for Jayne. Her studio, he explained in an aside, told him he'd better raise her neckline.

"Jayne doesn't like this—she says what will all her nice newspaper photographer friends say? She doesn't want to let them down. But the studio says the neckline goes up," said the energetic Bovee.

"But, anyway, back to the men's clothes—

"I'd like to see some of those sloppy slobs like Marlon Brando get into more attractive clothes. Most of these new clothes I designed for myself (he gets an award in Chicago June 20 as one of the country's best-dressed executives). I had so many requests for copies that I'm manufacturing my clothes for national distribution."

Bovee's ideas—revolutionary for men's wear—include evening shirts decorated with crocheted edges (but not frilly) and Sunday shirts of fancy white-on-white fabric.

Fur Hats Considered
He also hopes men will buy his bright red velvet dinner jackets, wool jersey suits (lined to prevent itching), black satin tuxedos with matching shoes, broadcloth coats with fur collars, ties copied after a bull-fighter's and even fur hats.

"Men wear fur hats in Europe—why not here?" demanded Bovee.

So far the designer has noted "some resistance" from stores that retail his creations. But he has a happy customer in actor Fernando Lamas. Even Jayne's boy friend, muscle king Mickey Hargitay, goes for Elgee's evening ties that consist of a satin ribbon criss-crossed but not tied in a bow.

"I'm also starting coordinated wardrobes for men and women," the designer added.
