A Good Drug for Cancer

At a recent meeting of the American Association of Pathologists and Bacteriologists in Washington, D. C., Drs. Oscar B. Hunter and C. Barrie Cook, of Washington, D. C., reported hopeful results obtained in 50 cases of cancer treated with a drug called ThioTEPA.

Hundreds of people write me, saying, "One of my loved ones has been found to have inoperable cancer. He has had some x-ray treatment, but the doctor is not hopeful. Is there any place to which I can take him and is there any new drug that is worth trying, or should, or should I go to a quack?" Usually, I say to these people, "I don't see much sense in your traveling about, because today knowledge about new drugs is disseminated so rapidly that doubtless your good doctor at home knows what has been discovered in every big center in the world. Any drug that has been tested thoroughly at places like the Memorial Hospital in New York, or the Argonne Hospital in Chicago, or the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, is probably available to leading physicians in every large city."

There are a number of drugs that will clear up cancer in small animals, but all of them have been rather toxic for men and women. Now, Drs. Hunter and Cook say that, in their experience, the best of the new drugs is ThioTEPA. It has fewer severe side reactions than have the other drugs, and its restraints the growth of more kinds of tumor than are affected by other drugs.

The doctors are careful to say that they don't look on this drug as a cure for cancer but it definitely inhibits the growth of cancer situated in the ovaries, lungs, stomach, liver, mouth, and pancreas, as well as the black cancers, the lymphomas, and Hodgkins' disease. It works well, also, in certain types of leukemia. In some cases, the patient's pain disappears, and he seems to get well. He may stay well for six months or more.

Battle Against Foreign Aid Seen

Washington — A key member of the house threatened Saturday a tough battle against President Eisenhower's foreign aid bill in the house this week.

The \$3,637,000,000 program won bipartisan approval in the senate Friday night. It was one of the administration's rare victories in the current battle of the budget.
