

### Mamie Undergoes Physical Checkup At Walter Reed

Washington — Mrs. Eisenhower today was undergoing a "routine physical checkup" at Walter Reed Army hospital.

White House Press Secretary James C. Hagerly said Mrs. Eisenhower will undergo a "top-to-toe" examination. He emphasized that the hospital visit was not prompted by any kind of illness.

Mrs. Eisenhower entered the hospital Monday. She was expected to remain several days.

The First Lady underwent her last checkup only four months ago. She has a heart murmur as a result of a childhood attack of rheumatic fever. But Hagerly said the hospital visit had "no relation at all" to that.

Reporters asked if Mrs. Eisenhower had been staying in bed at the White House lately, as she did in April during a presidential work-play visit in Augusta, Ga. Hagerly replied that the First Lady has been very active in recent weeks.

He added that she often takes the chance to rest up on out-of-town trips.

Mrs. Eisenhower spent three or four days in Walter Reed for her last check-up. Prior to that, she underwent a physical check-up in June of last year during the President's hospitalization for hepatitis.

Hagerly said the check-up was in keeping with Mr. and Mrs. Eisenhower's practice of getting regular physicals.

### Underworld Figure Slain in New York

New York — Frank Scallise, 55, reputed associate of Frank Costello and other underworld figures, was shot to death Monday as he was leaving a fruit and vegetable store in a tenement Bronx neighborhood.

The two gunmen, who fired at least five shots, fled in a waiting sedan double-parked in front of the store.

The proprietor of the store, Enrico Mazzero, from whom Scallise had just purchased 90 cents worth of produce, was held in \$100,000 bail as a material witness. Mazzero said the shooting took place so fast that he was unable to get a good look at the killers.

Assistant Bronx District Attorney Albert Blinder said the shooting had "all the earmarks" of a gangland slaying. He expressed the belief that the murder was linked with the international narcotics traffic. Federal authorities have suspected Scallise of having been involved in an international dope smuggling ring and of being a leader in an offshoot of the notorious Mafia.

Scallise was a former associate of one-time vice lord Charles (Lucky) Luciano.

### Economic Policies Being Investigated

Washington — Sen. Harry F. Byrd (D-Va.) opened a broad Senate investigation of government economic policies today with the statement that world confidence in the American dollar is the chief restraint on Russian aggression.

Secretary of Treasury George M. Humphrey, the dominant figure in framing economic policies for the Eisenhower administration, was called as the first witness in the inquiry being handled by Byrd's Senate Finance Committee.

In his opening statement, Byrd said the committee wanted to know why taxes, interest rates, public and private debt, the cost of living and the federal budget are so high.

He said the investigation would be the first full-dress study of fiscal and money policy since one conducted by a government commission in 1908.

"The immediate occasion for this study is the existing credit and interest situation and, more important, inflation which has started again with its ominous threat to fiscal solvency, sound money and individual welfare," he said.

### Terry Moore Files Suit for Divorce

Santa Monica, Calif. — Actress Terry Moore today sought a divorce from wealthy Panama broker Eugene McGrath on the ground that he was too friendly with other women and gambled heavily.

Miss Moore filed the divorce suit Monday in superior court here through her attorney, Jerry Giesler. The complaint said the curvaceous movie star didn't want alimony because she was "well able to support and to take care of herself."

The 28-year-old actress and McGrath, 34, eloped to Las Vegas, Nev., Jan. 1, 1956 and separated June 8 of this year. She previously had been the wife of football star Glen Davis.
