

Barbara Hall Hits Quiz Show Jackpot On Shakespeare

New York—Showgirl Barbara Hall hit the jackpot Tuesday night on the "564,000 Question" and won the chance to try for prizes up to \$250,000.

The 24-year-old Pittsburgh, Pa. charmer answered a 13-part question about Shakespeare to win \$64,000 on the CBS television quiz show.

Younger Quits
Another contestant, Michael Mark, 12, of Minneapolis, Minn., elected to keep \$16,000 he had won on two previous appearances on the show.

Nile Page, 46, bearded ice cream vendor from Canoga Park, Calif., won \$4,000 by correctly answering a question about the Bible. He will return next week to try for \$8,000.

Miss Hall was aided by an expert she had chosen. He was Dr. Austin Wright, professor of English literature at Miss Hall's alma mater, Carnegie Institute of Technology in Pittsburgh. Completed Acrostic

The showgirl, who appeared in the recently closed "Ziegfeld Follies" on Broadway, was required to complete an acrostic printed on a plexiglas window of her isolation booth, from clues to words which began with each of the letters of "Shakespeare."

For the second part of the question Miss Hall had to name the plays in which two characters appear.

Miss Hall returns next week for the first of three questions leading to the \$128,000 plateau. If successful, she could win as much as \$250,000 if she chose to answer further questions.
