Ballot Titles Given At General Election Twelve Measures Due

Salem—Ballot titles for 12 measures that will be voted on by the people in the November, 1958, general election were announced today by Attorney General Robert Y. Thornton. They are:

Fixing state boundaries: Repeals obsolete constitutional provision describing state boundaries. Authorizes modifying of existing state boundaries by interstate agreement with approval of Congress.

Temporary appointment and assignment of judges: To authorize the Supreme Court to appoint temporary judges to the Supreme Court and lower courts and to assign lower court judges to serve temporarily outside of the district for which they were elected.

Increasing funds for war veterans' loans: To increase from four per cent to six per cent of the assessed valuation of all the property in the state as the maximum limitation on the amount of state bonds that may be issued to raise funds to make farm and home loans to World War II and Korean war veterans.

Grand Jury Bill Up  
Special grand jury bill: To authorize the Legislature to enact laws permitting the calling of a special grand jury.

Repealing death penalty: To eliminate the death penalty for first degree murder.

Salaries of state legislators: To amend Oregon constitution by increasing salaries of state legislators from \$600 to \$1200 per year.

Authorizes discontinuing certain state tuberculosis hospitals. To permit the Board of Control to discontinue using the Eastern Oregon and University State tuberculosis hospitals, in whole or in part. Board could designate the use for any other state institution or agency.

County home rule amendment: Authorizes the voters in any county to adopt charter to provide for the exercise of authority over matters of county concern. Initiative and referendum powers also are reserved to the legal voters of counties adopting a charter.

Nuclear Power Mentioned  
Authorizing different use of state institution: Authorizes the Legislature to alter, reduce, enlarge or terminate the use or purpose of any state institution located outside Marion county any time after 10 years from the date of the election which located the institution.

State power development: Empowers the state to acquire and develop water, thermal and nuclear power generating facilities. State may develop electrical energy for transmission and sale on wholesale basis or directly to industries using 10,000 kilowatts or more.

Cairo—Egypt will spend \$22,400,000 of this year's Suez Canal revenues for improvements on the waterway, the weekly newspaper Akher Saa said today. The weekly also said Egyptian minesweepers had cleared all mines from the Gulf of Suez.

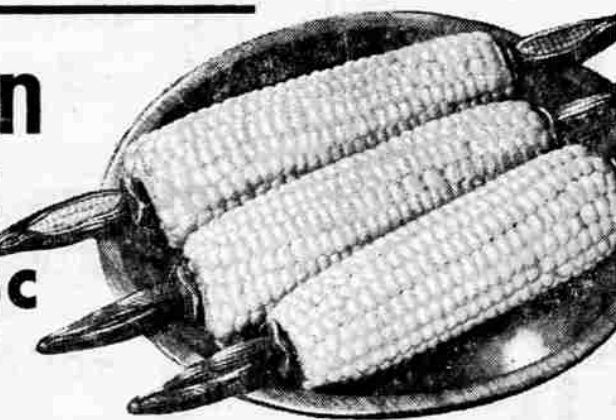
