For entertaining in the night club annex of a Las Vegas, Nev., gambling joint, Jack Benny was paid \$40,000 a week. How can any night spot afford such a salary? 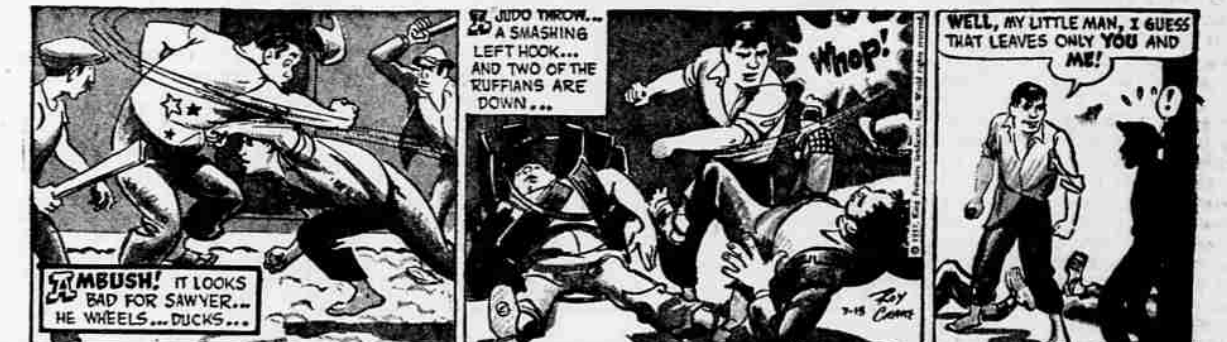
