"I had just about had it," confessed Vivian at her Pacific Palisades home. "I toyed with the thought of playing some other character. I know how Art Carney feels — since the Jackie Gleason show is off Art is happy as a clam working on dramatic shows."

"I wanted to break out and do something else. But, you know, you just can't quit. Oh, I got letters, all wanting to know if Bill and I would be on the new show. Gamma Globulin Lack May Bring Infection
Pittsburgh—Two University of Pittsburgh scientists warn that children with bone defects may be suffering from a blood condition that lowers their resistance to infections. Drs. William J. Kuhns and Irwin A. Solow have discovered that persons with bone and skin defects may have a shortage of gamma globulin in the blood. Since the gamma globulin (GG) contains most of the antibodies that fight disease, such persons are easy prey to all sorts of infections. The condition may be relieved by monthly shots of gamma globulin.

Barbados Native Has Musical Note To His English

There is a special lilt to the language of the native, so that his English comes out with a musical Scots overtone. But the baffling (confusing) words and phrases he has come up with over the past three centuries is enough to hag (worry) a visitor to death.
