A New Treatment for Diabetes: Diabetics are all agog over the recent release of the new tolbutamide that can be taken by mouth instead of by injection.

It is going to help a considerable percentage of the persons who get a mild type of diabetes sometime after the age of 30. It is not good for persons with a severe or a complicated type of diabetes.

New Advances in Psychiatry: I was interested to see the report that at the Chicago meeting of the American Psychiatric Association, Dr. Robert G. Heath, Professor of psychiatry at Tulane, warned that psychoanalytic treatment is not good for persons with "schizo-types," the common form of psychosis.
