"There's no feud with Jayne Mansfield," Zsa Zsa says in her crazy, shook-up accent. "I just don't like her. If I want a feud I find someone bigger."

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This presumably means someone of larger stature.

Off to London to star in a new picture, "The Queen and Smith," Zsa Zsa believes she is launching a new career. It is her second serious dramatic role in succession. Her last film was "The Girl in the Kremlin."

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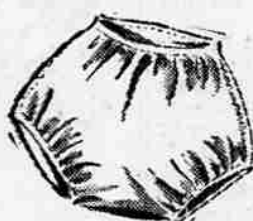
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
