6,458 Landings Made At Airport in July

A total of 6,458 aircraft landings were made at the Medford airport during July, according to the monthly report of municipal activities.

The total is 130 more than July of last year and 762 more than June. Civil aircraft contributed the largest number with 5,618, followed by air carrier with 764. The Air Force made 66 and the Navy 11 landings.

A total of 3,938 passengers boarded commercial airlines at the airport during the month, while 3,804 departed. The Medford airport had 10,510 pounds of airmail outbound while 7,679 pounds of mail arrived.

Frank F.—Whoever heard of a girl crazy enough to throw over a guy because he has too much money? That's my finance, Rose.

We are both in our middle 20s and were planning to get married in the fall. We have both been working for around six years and have saved quite a bit of money. Rose's family was going to buy our furniture as a wedding gift.
