Raccoon Returns to Campus; New Sock Dress Introduced

Raccoon is back on the campus. One New York store (Saks Fifth Avenue) featured raccoon collars on camel's hair coats, and for the accessories — bags, caps and gloves.

College girls also are going

for what the St. Louis clothing manufactureres call the "sock" dress. It is so-called because it borrows the Argyle patterns of men's socks and adapts them to a woven wool jersey, designed on lines so simple the dress is as easy as a sock to slip into. It has a drawstring belt, cardigan neckline and brief sleeves.

Coeds have their choice between the bold and muted plaid for their fall wardrobes. The bold ones pair such off-beat combinations as green and blue, or hot pink and red. The muted ones usually are a blend of various charcoal tones.

Up until now, most mothers have considered a white cloth raincoat for the children just about as practical as a milk baby bib. But today, manufacturers are trying to put the washable label on virtually all items in infants' and children's ready-to-wear. This includes rain-wear.

One firm is using a new washable poplin in white rain capes and hooded toggle coats for youngsters of toddler through sub-teen sizes. The poplin is treated with a special water repellent finish on the outer surface and a rubberized backing on the under side.

Another white raincoat is of specially-treated chambray. Both the poplin and chambray can be washed in warm soap or detergent suds, preferably by hand.

Upholstery emblems of Italian family crests decorate cashmere sweaters by Picard of Sun Valley. He gets the emblems from upholstery shops in Florence, Italy, and trims them with rhinestones, pearls and colored stones. The emblems themselves are new, but many of the designs are more than 300 years old.

Fashion designer Jo Copeland believes that woman's sense of style is "born, not made." Says the New York designer, "a woman can learn to be well-dressed. But a sense of style is a natural talent... she has to have it if she ever really becomes a symbol of fashion. I think that a woman shows much of her style sense in the way she accessorizes her clothes."
