SHINGLES IN OLD PEOPLE

Hundreds of people ask about shingles. They are blisters that usually follow the course of a nerve. The trouble is due to a viral inflammation in the little ganglion on one of the roots of the nerve.

A u r t h o r i t i e s believe that this virus is the same one that produces chicken-pox in children.

The medical name for it is herpes, and these little blisters can come anywhere on the body. Many people get a herpetic blister or two on their upper lip whenever they have a cold. This suggests that some of us carry the virus about with us much of the time. Only occasionally will it cause trouble.

That people can carry viruses around with them was shown during the early day of exploration, when sailors arriving in the South Seas, after months of travel, would give the natives measles and smallpox and other epidemic diseases.

Fortunately, in young people, the blisters of herpes soon dry up, and that is usually the end of the trouble, but in older people, shingles can be followed by a very painful neuralgia, which may persist for many months. Then, only strong pain-relievers can do any good.

Injections of a drug called Protamide will sometimes help. Several people have written me to say that they got some help when their doctor sprayed the painful area with ethyl chloride which freezes the skin

Young Japanese Finds Way Back to Portland

Portland — (U) — A persistent young Japanese has a yen for Portland has found his way back to the Rose City again. But he isn't expected to stay long.

Joe Onitru, whose real name Matsuoshi, was picked up at the home of a Portland detective who was once his benefactor.

Police said Joe had stowed away on the SS Hunter Victory in Japan and swam ashore at Tacoma last week. He was found here Sunday at the home of Detective Ron McKenzie after he was recognized by an neighbor. The McKenzies were not at home.

Joe, about 24, has twice been deported to Japan, the last time last year.

Immigration authorities prepared to send him back again, despite Joe's protest that he doesn't want to go back. "It no good for me," he said.

Joe's first encounter with authorities here was in 1951 when he was found hiding under newspaper along NW St. Helens road. McKenzie "adopted" him but Joe later got into trouble and the subsequent deportations followed.

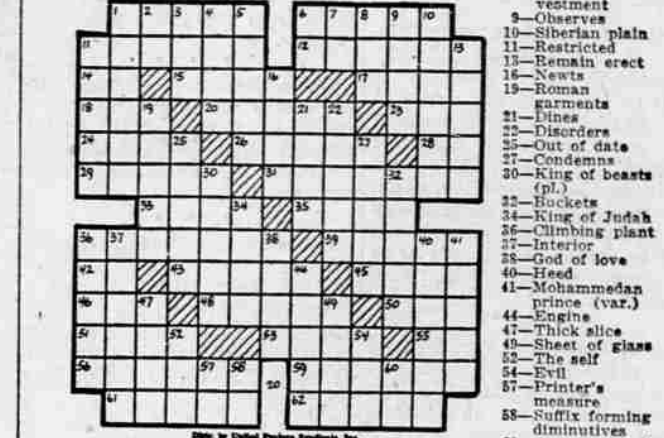
