THE NEW POET LAUREATE

Ethel Fuller Named Poet Laureate

Salem — (U) — Ethel Fuller, Portland, was named Oregon's poet laureate Saturday by Gov. Robert D. Holmes.

Mrs. Fuller came to Clatsop County in 1906 from Michigan and then has gained an international reputation in the field of poetry.

The new poet Laureate, 74, becomes the second in state's history to be designated by an Oregon governor. Hur Lampman held the post many years until his death in 1954.

With no official provision for a poet laureate, the position has been vacant since that time, though an unsuccessful attempt was made in the 1957 Legislature to create the office.

First Radio Editor Dies In Bay Region

Funeral services in San Mateo, Calif., for Thomas Nunan, 89, first radio editor on the Pacific Coast, were attended recently by Mrs. John Mansfield, 1615 Crater Lake ave.

Mr. Nunan was reported also as a member of the San Francisco Examiner staff for many years. He was considered one of the most versatile newspaper men in San Francisco's history, covering during his 40 years' service everything from police to water front beats, music and drama. He also wrote a poetry column.

Mr. Nunan's wife, Eula Howard Nunan, is a daughter of Eudora Godfrey Howard who taught school in Jacksonville in the early days.

While in the San Francisco bay area, Mrs. Mansfield also attended the funeral of Donald F. Herriot in Millbrae. Mr. Herriot is a former Medford resident. He lived in San Francisco bay area since 1932.
