Proprietor of Diner Convinced It's Jinxed

Rochester, N. Y.—George Vesel bent over to tie a shoelace in the living quarters of the diner he operates — and the next thing he knew he had a box car for company.

"Looking up to see fixtures come crashing down, Vesel said he 'thought it was an earthquake.' He smashed a window, cutting his wrist, and fled in fright. Then he turned to see what had happened.

A diesel locomotive left unattended in nearby yards with its engine running had started up, picking up a meat-loaded box-car on the rails a short distance ahead and shunted it on through a bumper stop into the rear wall of Vesel's diner.

The 58-year-old proprietor, who had just spent \$2,000 on the diner to repair damage from a fire, had reason to believe the eatery was jinxed.

Material Output To Gain 100 Per Cent

Los Angeles—Dr. George H. Hildebrand, nationally known labor economist, believes that automation, atomic and solar power as well as other technological advances will increase the nation's material output by as much as 100 per cent by 1967.

With this increase will come great changes in industrial relations, Hildebrand added.

"We are," he said, "on the threshold of a new era of unprecedented industrial productivity which will have an enormous impact on the traditional relations between management and labor."

Good industrial relations, as the doctor defined them, mean nothing more complicated than agreement on certain established economic concepts, a knowledge of human relations techniques and respect for the principle of collective bargaining.

Cool As a Cucumber

New York—Next time a seafood salad is on the menu, try it with a "different" dressing. Shred an unpeeled cucumber to give about 1/2 cup. Blend the cucumber into 1 cup mayonnaise, add a bit of chopped onion and serve.

For a really superb apple pie, make it with green apples and serve warm with a sherry wine sauce.

Hot Mocha

New York—Hot mocha is a delicious beverage to serve on chilly autumn days. Combine 2 tablespoons cocoa, 2 tablespoons sugar, a dash of salt and 1/4 cup water. Boil 1 minute. Stir in 2 cups milk and 2 cups coffee. Heat and add 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract.

'Gluability' Depends On Electrical Changes

Ann Arbor, Mich.—Ever wonder what makes glue stick? So have scientists, and here's the answer according to Alan A. Marra, associate professor of wood technology at the University of Michigan. But you have to be a bit of a scientist to understand the answer.

"Gluability doesn't depend on the roughness of the surface, as is popularly supposed. It depends on the same forces which hold all materials together.

"These forces basically are the result of unequal distribution of electrical changes in molecules and they operate in the same way as the attractive forces in a common bar magnet. But an adhesive deploys these forces differently and makes some available for holding onto something besides itself.

"This is accomplished by letting the adhesive pass through a fluid stage while it's in contact with the surface to which it must adhere. Every surface

has left-over forces which aren't being used to hold anything since there is no material on one side, and these provide points of anchorage for the adhesive forces."

So Marra suggests that if glue fails, it may have hardened before it could contact all available surfaces or the forces which would hold it are covered with dirt or some contamination.

For The Waistline

New York—Here's a dessert for the waistline watchers. Arrange fresh grapefruit sections and cranberry sauce in alternating layers in sherbet glasses. Chill and serve.

Chutney For Canapes

New York—Canapes suggestion: spread rounds of toast with chopped chutney, and top each with a sardine. Add a square of bacon and broil until bubbly.

Nothing makes pan fried fish taste better than a topping of roasted almonds. Pack a 5-ounce can of buttered diced roasted almonds along with your supplies for a weekend fishing trip.
