Improved Stopper

Designed for Ladles

Buffalo, N. Y. — Development of a safer stopper-head for huge ladles that promises to lessen pouring accidents in steel mills and prevent costly stoppage is disclosed by the Electric Refractories and Abrasives Co.

The improved stopper is reported to be able to regulate the flow of molten steel for many as 50 times during a single heat without giving indications of cracking from heat shock or "spalling." This is important because stopper failure could result in an uncontrollable flood of molten metal to cause worker casualties. It also can mean serious steel loss — as much as 250 tons in some cases.

The new stopper is made of flake graphite, fused silica and fire refractory clay. For operating temperatures above normal 2,900 F., aluminum oxide is added to the mixture.

It is said to be so durable that it can be removed from a white hot furnace and placed on a cold floor without crack-
