



Hospitality Outdoors



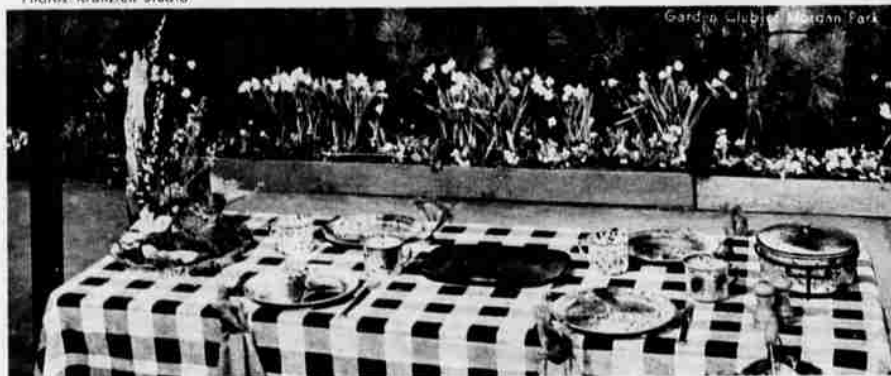

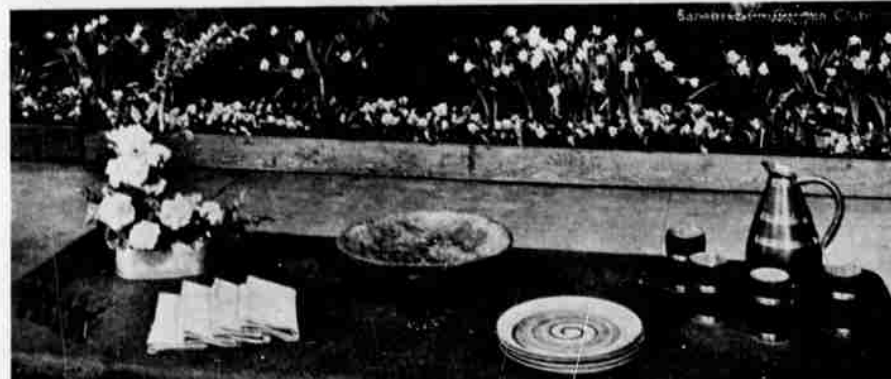
Checkerboard cloth adds sparkle to informal terrace setting which features enamelware.
