THE TREATMENT OF GOUT

Gout is characterized by acute, sudden and often very painful attacks of arthritis, commonly in one joint, and usually in the big toe joint. Following an attack, the patient may be normal quite a while, and then suddenly he will get another attack.

The trouble is usually due to a hereditary factor in the body's handling of certain substances which end up as uric acid. The disease occurs almost always in men, and rarely in women. It can occur in men who drink more alcohol than they need, and in men who eat much more than they should. But there is not only the "rich-man's champagne gout," there is a "poor-man's gout."

Unfortunately, many years ago the diagnosis was usually missed because we physicians had not been trained to think of gout; we thought it was a very rare disease, when actually arthritis experts now see a lot of it. Sometimes the doctor can diagnose gout in a minute by noticing little white masses of uric acid crystals under the skin of an ear or an elbow, or he can see peculiar spots in an X-ray film. Any many of middle age who wakes around 2 in the morning with an agonizing pain and red swelling in one big toe joint can know he almost certainly has the gout.

In cases of doubt, the doctor will get a laboratory worker to measure the amount of uric acid in the blood. In cases of gout this reading is usually elevated and somewhere between 5 and 9 mg., instead of the usual 1 to 4 mg. Sometimes these people have some albumin in the urine, or stones in a kidney, or bursitis of a shoulder joint. In one to five cases the patient has a rela-

Police Task Force Hunt Clues to Murder

Chicago—A special police task force and a battery of scientists joined forces today in an intensive hunt for clues into the slaying of a 15-year-old girl whose body was dismembered and stuffed into oil drums.

About 200 policemen, armed with questionnaires, made a house-to-house search of the victim's normally peaceful West Side neighborhood. Other officers investigated a host of telephone tips.

Scientists engaged in a detailed examination of skin and internal tissues from the dismembered body of Judith Mae Anderson in an effort to pin down the exact time and cause of her death.

Coroner Walter E. McCarron set an inquest for Wednesday afternoon, at which time the pathologists will make their report.

A preliminary investigation indicated Judith Mae died from a bullet wound in the head. Her butchered body was found jammed into two oil drums floating in a Lake Michigan harbor.
