The Medical Roundup

THE SPIRIT OF SCIENCE

There is still need today for explaining to laymen why many scientists take vows of poverty, much as a priest does, and plan to spend their days in a laboratory searching for the answers to certain questions. Often these searches will seem to be of little if any use, but some day, all of a sudden, some discovery will turn out to be of enormous value.

For instance, Dr. Fleming in his little pathological laboratory became curious as to why bacteria did not grow in the zone immediately surrounding a colony of a certain mold. Every housewife has seen such colonies on the top of some of her jars of jam. Fleming realized that there must be some substance seeping out from the edges of the colony to keep bacteria from growing.

All bacteriologists must have noticed this phenomenon a thousand times, but he was the only one to see that there might be a chemical there, which, if isolated and injected into the body of a man, might save his life from severe infection. He was the only man to do something about it. Eventually, penicillin was found. It was purified by Dr. Florey and others, and by now, it must have saved a million lives.

As I walk through public parks it saddens me to see that most of the statues on pedestals are of men whose only virtue was that they were experts in the art of killing their fellows. Only rarely do I find a statue of a man like Pasteur, who probably did more for humanity than did any other man who ever lived. No one erects a memorial

to Dr. William G. Morton who did most to give us the great boon of anesthesia in surgery, or to Lord Lister, who made modern surgery possible, or to Dr. Domagk, who found the sulfa drugs. We men and women show little gratitude to our greatest benefactors.

It never would have occurred to me to worry about inhaling a little smoke from the cigar of the man sitting next to me at a dinner party, but some people are now worrying about this. I am sure the small amount of smoke they will get in this way will never harm them!

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Charges of Homicide Dismissed in Newport

Newport, Ore.—Two charges of negligent homicide against Raymond Buckland Hutchinson, 24, Portland, involving a car-panel truck collision east of Otis Junction July 30, 1956, were dismissed here Monday by Lincoln county Circuit Judge Richard Anderson.

Lincoln county District Attorney A. R. McMullen told the court he had no new evidence on the case, and Judge Anderson dismissed the charges against Hutchinson for lack of evidence.

The district attorney sought to prove Hutchinson had been under the influence of liquor one year ago last month when his car collided with a pickup truck at Rose Lodge, fatally injuring Carl L. Lieberman, 50, of Neotsu. Jack Loose, 32, a passenger in Hutchinson's car, was also killed.

A Lincoln county grand jury had indicted Hutchinson, a longshoreman, May 29, in connection with the two deaths.

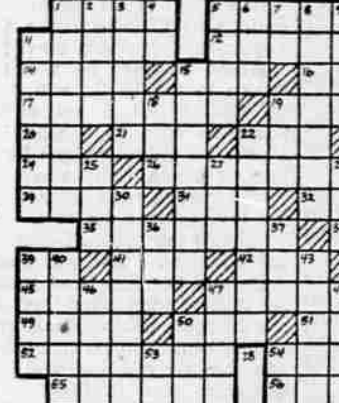
