The Medical Roundup

BOOKLETS HELPFUL

I regret that recently, when I mentioned that I have written a booklet on arthritis, apparently I left the impression that it was to be sent free. As a result, hundreds of persons wrote for copies which I could not supply as they are sold by the publisher.

Because we physicians, when very busy and faced with patients asking many questions about nervousness, arthritis, heart disease, high blood pressure, a stomach ulcer, migraine, insomnia, a sore colon, allergy or cancer, cannot stop to give all the answers, I have long felt we should have at our disposal a series of inexpensive booklets that the inquirer can buy. I will send a list of my publications of this type to anyone who wants it, but I must emphasize that I have no free pamphlets for distribution.

Because hundreds of readers have asked me to write a book describing those symptoms that should cause them to hurry to a physician, and those symptoms that they needn't worry about, I have recently re-written and much enlarged my "Danger Signals" (Heintz Publ. Minneapolis, Minn., \$1.50). It contains, also, a detailed answer to another question that hundreds of people keep putting up to me. They say, "You keep remarking 'get a good family doctor,' but how can we find one, especially when we have recently moved to a state where we do not know anybody?" I suggest that they write to Mr. Mac Cahal, of the American Academy of General Practice (Volker Blvd., at Brooksline, Kansas City, 12, Mo.) for a list of some of the best-educated and up-to-date family doctors in the area in which they live. The Academy doctors have to keep studying to keep up-to-date, if they don't they lose their membership in the organization.

Also, I tell in "Danger Signals" about the huge directory of all licensed physicians and surgeons who, after many years of graduate training and then a stiff examination by a board of experts, have been licensed to practice as specialists. These very helpful books ought to be in all public libraries.

To show how useful these

books can be, the other day a woman wrote me that a man who called himself a "surgeon" had proposed to remove two-thirds of her stomach. Because she felt a bit disturbed about the fellow, she went to her old family physician who looked the man up and found that he was not listed as a surgeon. Then her doctor looked in the big directory and found no record of his ever having had any special training in surgery. Her doctor then chose for her a well-trained abdominal surgeon.
