

Dairy Drive-In Opens in Medford For Motor Traffic

The first "Dairy Drive-In" in the Rogue Valley opened in Medford this week.

Catering to motor traffic, the Village Dairy-Smith, located at East Main and Genesee sts., carries a complete line of dairy products including ice cream, milk, butter, eggs, cheese, and bread, and boasts "50 second service," to shoppers.

Proprietor is Vince Smith, a comparative new-comer to the Rogue Valley.

Entered in North Platt, Neb., Smith reared Oregon State College at Corvallis after army service, "because it is the only college in the west that offers a complete program in dairy bacteriology and chemistry." He received his masters degree there in 1951.

Plant Manager

He was manager of Oregon's famous Langlois Blue Cheese plant at Langlois until it was destroyed by fire in 1954. He then came to Medford to establish the Blue Cheese plant at Rogue River Valley Creamery in Central Point.

In 1956, Smith purchased the distributorship of Gilman's Dairy, an old established plant near Medford, which he still retains.

"Dairy drive-ins are an established service in most large cities," Smith stated, "and it seemed only progressive to offer the same kind of service to the people of Medford."

The Smiths live at 822 Sherman st. with their four children, two boys and two girls. They are members of the First Baptist church where Smith is president of the Men's Organization and teaches the high-school boys' class.

950 Drivers Get Licenses Suspended

Salem — Nearly 950 Oregon residents had their licenses to drive suspended last month after angling with Oregon's traffic laws.

But the drivers who lost licenses were but a small portion of the number in trouble as Oregon courts reported a total of 11,407 traffic violation convictions for August.

Reasons for license suspensions, according to the August report from the department of motor vehicles, included:

Driving while intoxicated, 275; reckless driving, 68; violation of basic rule, 46; hit and run, 10; failure to report an accident, 39; driving record—too frequent accidents or convictions—91; and involvement in fatal accident, 9.

One hundred and six drivers had to be given additional periods of suspension under Oregon law because they were found to be driving while already suspended.

Three-Year-Old Killed When Car Slips Brakes

Salem — Rickie Garrison, three-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Alvin Garrison of Stayton, suffered fatal injuries Friday when a car parked on an incline slipped its brakes and rolled over him.

The Linn county sheriff's office said the accident occurred near Lyons on the Scio highway. The boy apparently had been playing around the parked car.

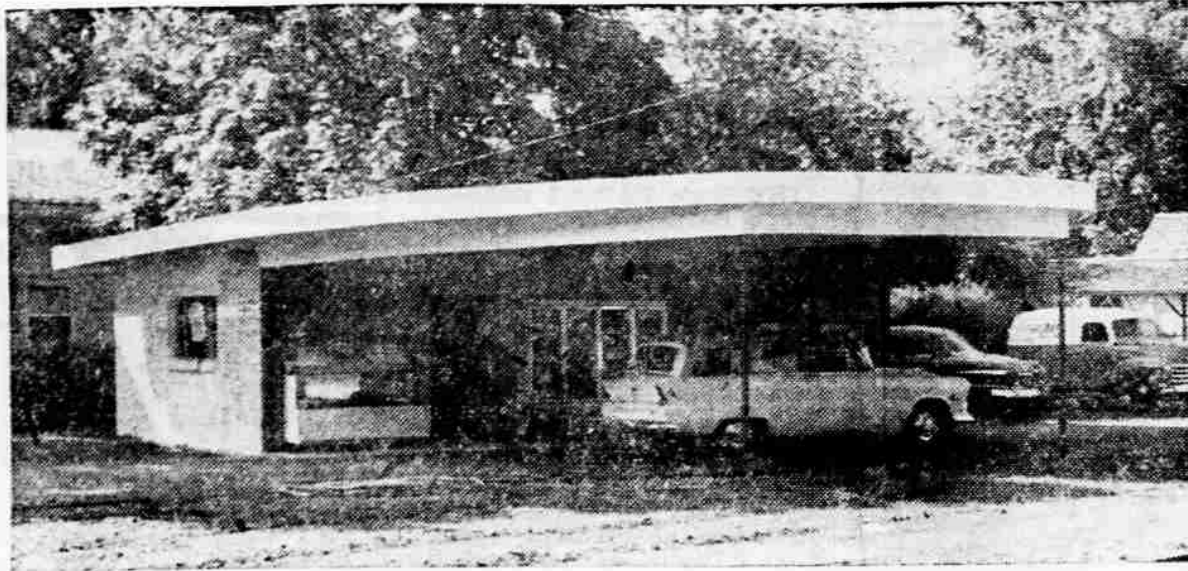

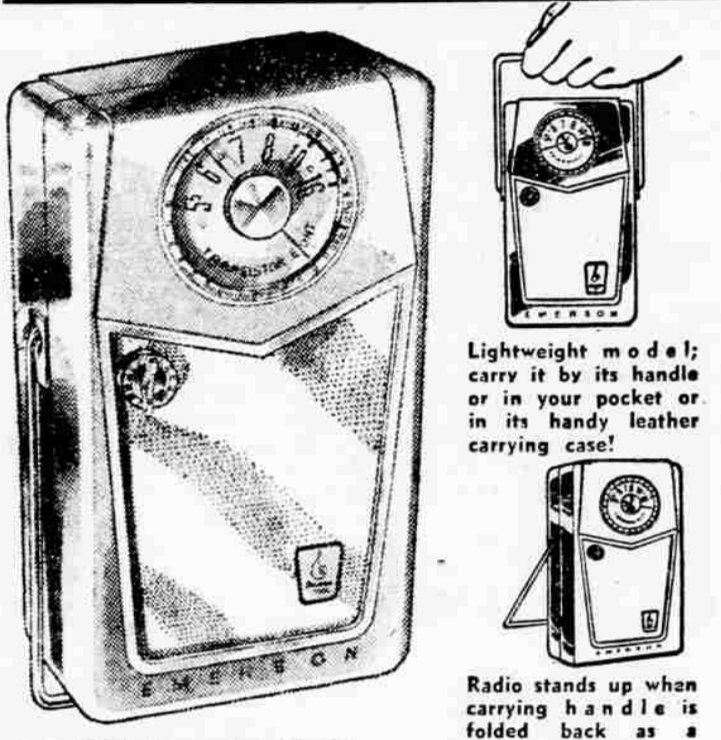
