

Chessman Names Real Bandit But Has Sworn Attorney To Secrecy

New York — **UP** — Convict-author Caryl Chessman, whose latest appeal to escape the gas chamber will be heard in Los Angeles next Monday, said today that he has named to his attorney the person who committed the crimes he is charged with, but has sworn her to secrecy.

In his third book, "The Face Of Justice," published by Prentice-Hall today, Chessman said he has prepared a secret package containing a document that identifies the "two actual red light bandits," affidavits and photostats of police records, reports and other material proving that "the wrong man occupies

Cell 2455, death row." He said only one of the two has "any degree of importance."

His attorney, Rosalie Asher, said in Sacramento, Calif., that Chessman had given her the name of the man "who he claims is the red-light bandit." She said Chessman asked her "never to reveal it" and for that reason she can do nothing with the information.

Death Row's Oldest

Chessman, 36, was convicted nine years ago on 17 counts of robbery, burglary, kidnapping and sex offenses, and has lived on death row longer than any other person in U.S. history. He left San Quentin Prison last Tuesday in the custody of California authorities to prepare his case for the Monday appeal hearing in Superior Court in Los Angeles.

In "The Face of Justice," the second book he has smuggled to his publishers from prison, Chessman repeatedly declares his innocence of his 1948 conviction under California's "Little Lindbergh Law."

Chessman said he was pessimistic about his chances of survival. He said he has an ulcer and fears for his sanity. He wrote his latest book in violation of the warden's orders, typing the first drafts on sheets of carbon paper which guards disregarded. He said that he nearly went blind copying from the carbons onto manuscript paper.

Marked by Fingerprints

Chessman signed each page and put his fingerprints on it with ink so that his agent could verify the authenticity of the manuscript. He said he found a "security hole" in San Quentin "big enough to drive a truck through" that enabled him to smuggle the manuscript out. He

probably no one will ever know "how I got it out."

Chessman has kept the case constantly before the courts by his own legal efforts and those of his attorneys. He is seeking a new trial on grounds that the stenographer at his Los Angeles trial died before his notes were transcribed, leaving some testimony in doubt. But he has little hope.

"I expect to be put to death in that lethal chamber soon—barring a judicial miracle or an 'impossible' and unparalleled feat of black magic," he wrote.

He noted in the book that he has seen one woman and 69 men go to the San Quentin gas chamber.

Grace Expecting Baby in March

Monte Carlo — **UP** — A palace press office spokesman said tonight Prince Rainier and Princess Grace are expecting a baby next March.

A communique said: "The palace of the Prince of Monaco announces that a happy event is expected by their most serene highnesses, the sovereign Prince and Princess Grace, for the month of next March."

The announcement put an end to months of rumors that the former movie actress and her prince would have another child. Their first child, Princess Caroline Louise Marguerite, was born here last Jan. 23.

Both the Prince and the princess have expressed hope that their next child would be a son. At present, Princess Caroline is listed as heir-presumptive to the throne. But she would yield precedence if the next child is a boy.

Princess Grace is the former Grace Kelly of Philadelphia. Rainier is the scion of the centuries-old ruling house of Grimaldi.

San Marino Reds Refuse To Leave Palace Quarters

San Marino — **UP** — Communist officials barricaded themselves in the government palace today to frustrate any attempt by an anti-Communist regime from moving in and taking over control of this tiny republic on Italy's Adriatic coast.

This 38-square-mile republic, the world's oldest and tiniest, Thursday found itself with two rival governments after days of political maneuvering.

Fist Fight Erupts

The battle for control exploded into a melee of fistfighting in the town square between some 600 Communist supporters, brought in from the fields and factories, and anti-Communist councilors.

Thursday night, Communist officials moved into the 15th century government palace, bed and baggage. Outside the palace, party henchmen set up an all-night guard, sitting on the cobble pavement nursing straw-covered flasks of chianti wine and waving away all who came near.

General Elections

Secretary of State Domenico Moganti stuck his head out of a window Thursday night and announced the republic would hold general elections on Nov. 3. He indicated the Communists would not leave the palace before then.

The Communists, who have ruled this mountain-top enclave since World War II, Thursday dissolved the ruling Grand and General Council, which serves as parliament.

But the anti-Communists, led by the Christian Democrats, immediately charged that the Red action was illegal and set up a rival executive council.

New Zealand Prime Minister Quits Post

Wellington, New Zealand — **UP** — Prime Minister Sidney G. Holland of New Zealand resigned today because of illness and an eye complaint, it was announced.

Gov. Gen. Sir Willoughby Norrie called on Deputy Prime Minister K. J. Holyoake to take over the post.

KOREAN CABINET RESIGNS

Tokyo — **UP** — The North Korean Supreme Peoples Assembly has accepted the resignation of the entire cabinet and has asked Premier Kim Il Sung to submit a plan for a new cabinet, the Communist New China News Agency reported today. No reason for the cabinet change was given other than the fact that "its mission is done." The outgoing cabinet will continue its duties until a new one is formed," the agency said.

AFL-CIO LISTS WORTH

Washington — **UP** — The AFL-CIO reported Thursday that as of last June 30 its net worth was \$6,330,613. The labor organization's biggest asset was its ultra-modern Washington headquarters building valued at close to \$5 million. President George Meany and Secretary-Treasurer William F. Schnitzer together received a total of \$68,000 in salaries, the financial statement said.

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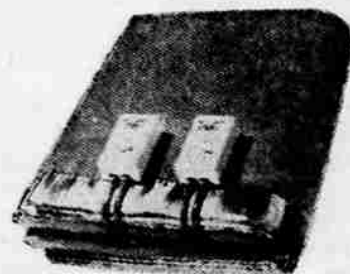
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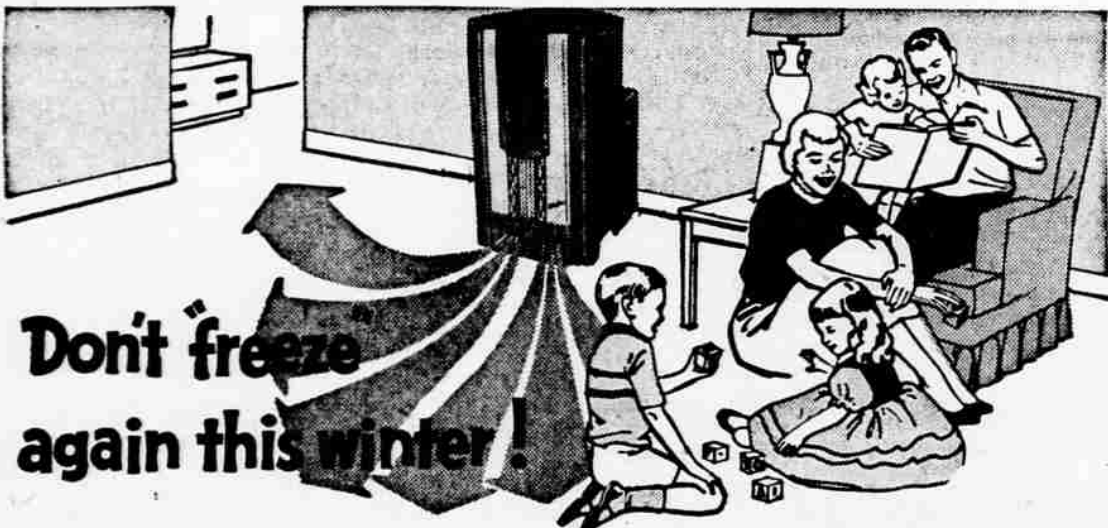
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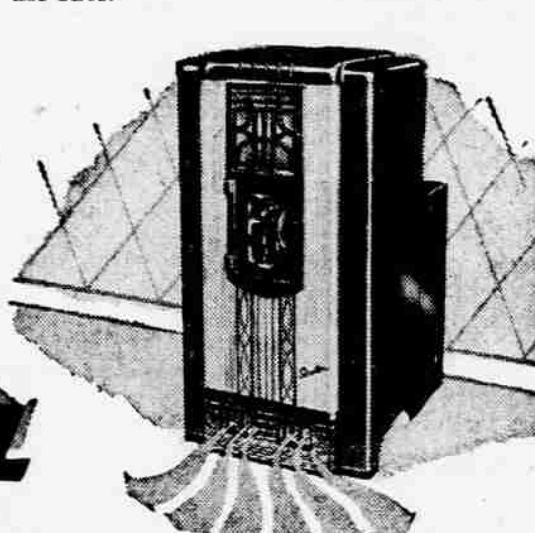
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
