Does The Stress Of Life Affect Longevity?

According to the Institute of Life Insurance, in 1900 the life expectancy of men was 46.3 years as against 48.3 years for women. In 1955 the corresponding figures were 66.7 and 73.6 years.

Many persons have felt that this sex difference in longevity must be due to the strenuous life that men now lead. To me, this isn't a good argument, because if the strain of life has greatly increased for men, why are they living on an average 20 years longer than they were living 55 years ago? Also, most persons who discuss this problem do not know that the great differences in the mortality of males and females shows up even in infancy. I often read that stomach ulcers occur 3 1/2 times more often in men than in women because of the strenuous life men lead.

But this doesn't impress me because there is a similar difference between the incidence of a disease called congenital pyloric stenosis. In this disease, children are born with such a thickening of the muscle around the outlet of the stomach that they vomit badly, and commonly have to be operated on. I could fill a column with descriptions of troubles that are three times more common in boy babies than in girl babies.

Recently, Father Francis C. Madigan, S. J., of the University of North Carolina, attacked the problem in a good way. He studied Catholic Brothers and Sisters in monasteries and convents where he feels that the strain on the two sexes is about equal. The Brothers are not subject to military service, after entering the religious life. Father Madigan studied the longevity of 9000 Brothers and 32,000 Sisters living between the periods of 1900 and 1954. He found that even in these quiet communities the women were outliving the men. The evidence indicated that the greater longevity of the women was due to their greater resistance to the degenerative diseases, such as diseases of the arteries and heart and kidneys.

Infectious Hepatitis and How One Gets It

Many persons want to know how they get their infectious hepatitis. Some, probably, just caught it from some other persons, but others appear to have gotten it from a transfusion. Because of the great danger in transfusions, I myself, would not have one if I could possibly get out of it. In spite of every effort that doctors make to choose a donor who hasn't had jaundice, they still keep getting hold of men who carry the virus in their blood.

Another way of getting hepatitis is to be given a "shot" of something with a needle that hasn't been boiled for 30 minutes. In the old days, we doctors thought it was safe enough to throw a needle into strong alcohol and leave it there, but today we know that the virus of hepatitis is hard to kill, and hence every hypodermic needle or lancet for taking a sample of blood must be thoroughly sterilized, either by dry heat or by long boiling.

A Small Cyst At The End Of The Spine

Many people want to know what a small cyst is at the end of the spine of their newborn baby. It may be what is called a

spina bifida, which is due to a failure of the two halves of the spine to come together and unite properly. In bad cases, little can be done. Sometimes in these cases there are defects in the nervous system of the legs, or there may be club feet. Expert neurologists and surgeons should be consulted.

In other cases, the little swelling is what is called a pilonidal cyst. Again, the treatment is surgical. Unfortunately, it often is difficult to get the whole thing out so it won't come back again.

A Hairy Mole On The Face

I have never been able to understand why good-looking women will keep an ugly mole, and perhaps a hairy mole, on their face when in three minutes any good skin specialist could remove it without causing any pain. He would first inject some procaine under it, and then, with a needle attached to an electrical apparatus, he would desiccate or burn away the mole with very hot sparks. In a week or so the scar would fall off and after some months the scar would be almost invisible.
