CORDUROY (perhaps literally "corde du roi"—the king's cord) has come of age! For centuries synonymous with work clothes, corduroy for some time has been associated with children's durable clothing. In the last decade or so it has been used extensively for sportswear; and today, royally treated, we find corduroy the fashion for sophisticated after-dark apparel. In wide and fine wales, vertically or horizontally placed, worn long or short, corduroy is very much in style.

1. Blair's ankle-length dinner skirt of wide-wale corduroy has slanting hip pockets (\$37). The perfect companion is a full-sleeved cotton chiffon blouse, so feminine with generously proportioned bow tied at the plunged neckline (\$23).

2. Mr. Mort gives us a slim party suit in wide-wale, horizontally cut corduroy. The blouse, cut low in back, has a bateau neckline and is of the same leopard-printed crepe that lines the smart, winged-tip jacket (\$50 complete).

3. A formal affair: Nelly de Grab's ensemble of fine-wale corduroy. Lined in Interlon, the skirt will retain its fullness (\$18). The fitted hip-length jacket (\$9) is designed to be worn with or without a soft raccoon collar (\$35).
