The Family Council

Editor's note: The Family Council consists of a judge, a psychiatrist, three clergymen, a newspaper editor, a women's editor and two writers. Each article is a summary of an actual report. The Family Council does not give advice; it merely reports on problems that have been dealt with by responsible agencies and counselors.

Mrs. H. P. — My daughter-in-law beats the children.

Eileen P. — I'm grateful for the spankings I got.

Mrs. H. P. — I never thought I'd be an interfering mother-in-law, but it seems to have happened to me in spite of myself.

I have brought up five children without ever laying a hand to one of them, so I know it can be done. My daughter-in-law, however, thinks it can't be done. She has twin boys of 4 and a baby a year old, so I realize things are hard for her and I try to give her a hand by coming every day and watching the boys for a few hours.

But I just can't take it when I see Eileen beat those boys. They are devilish, but no worse than other children of their age. She whips the daylight out of them when they misbehave and I just can't stand back and watch. Recently I just told her off good and proper and she told me if I feel that way I can just keep my nose out of her business. I was never so hurt in my life.

Eileen P. — I apologized for speaking as I did to my mother-in-law, but I still think that I was right and she has no right to interfere between me and my children—no matter what I do.

My mother-in-law thinks she's so superior. She did things this way and that way and everything came out just too perfect. Well, in my family we got spanked—and how! It didn't do us any harm and I'm downright grateful to my mother for letting me know right from wrong in a way I could remember.

My boys aren't suffering as a result of their spankings. They go right back and do the same things ten minutes later or they come to me saying, "I love Mommy." I can't be such a terrible mother if my sons say they love me.

My mother-in-law has gotten my husband all worked up about this thing, too. Now, when he comes home at night, he asks the boys if I hit them.

The Council: Taking one problem at a time—Mrs. H. P. was wrong to interfere. Such interference would only be justified if Eileen were seriously abusing the children or showed she was not quite in command of herself when she punished them.

If Mrs. H. P. felt this was the case, she should have suggested to either Eileen or her own son that they talk the whole thing over with a doctor. If the spankings are moderate and Mrs. H. P. can't bear to witness them, she should stay out of the picture.

On the matter of spankings in general, most authorities agree today that there is little harm in them if the parents are responsible and affectionate and the home is happy. The anti-spanking school of thought came as a result of the abuse of this practice in hands of cruel, perverted individuals—and there are more of those around than most of us realize.

Eileen shows, however, that her spankings are not working out too well as a disciplinary measure. With three children at that hard-to-handle stage, she is probably using the spankings more as an outlet for her own nerves than anything else.

If her husband also objects to the spankings, she should enlist his cooperation in getting a little more help in the home. She should try to get a few hours a week for rest and relaxation—completely away from the children. It's hard, but it can be worked out if it is agreed this is necessary for the welfare of the family.
