

### Chin Up Club Annual Hobby Sale Set Friday, Saturday

### The Hollywood Scene

Hollywood — Boris Karloff, a reformed monster to be feared as if I'm letting down all come out of hiding Thursday night to frighten the bejambers out of those of us who still believe in Halloween.

"It's the busiest time of the year for me," Karloff said in a sepulchral tone while sipping a glass of tomato juice.

"I should raise my prices in October. Almost everyone wants me to be a guest on their shows, to terrify viewers. Quite flattering when you stop to think about it."

Karloff, who never won a beautiful baby contest, has added to his menacing demeanor by growing a scraggly white beard. Contrasted with his swarthy skin, and combined with convulsive rolling of his eyes, he is likely to scare the Russian secret police.

Proud of Old Films "Not only am I in demand for guest shots," he added, "every Halloween my old horror pictures are taken from the toms and replayed. It all makes me quite proud."

This Halloween is a departure for the man who frightened two generations of moviegoers. He turns song and dance man for Rosemary Clooney's video program Thursday night on NBC.

"Shocking," says Karloff. "This is hardly the way for a reformed monster to behave. I feel as if I'm letting down all the people who believe in me as Frankenstein's horrible monster."

Growing serious, the English-born actor explained that he appeared in only three Frankenstein pictures.

Indebted to Monster "The monster was the best friend I ever had. I'd been in Hollywood for 10 years and no one had heard of me except my creditors. Then in 1931 I played the monster and a career was born. I'm truly indebted to the old ghoul."

"I decided never to play another Frankenstein role because the monster eventually became nothing more than a comic prop," he grinned. "The shock value of his face wore off, and he became a compassionate character whom a person wanted to befriend. Audiences even became fond of the old boy."

Karloff hasn't given up scaring people. His latest picture, "Stranglehold," is a thriller about a Jekyll and Hyde-type character.

"Horror pictures will always be with us. They are a type of folklore," Karloff said.
