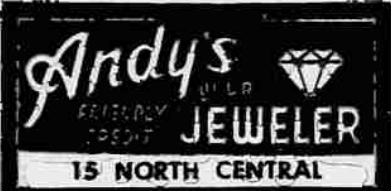

Mass X-Ray Term Said Misunderstood

People have misunderstood the use of the term mass X-ray, according to Dr. James T. Spero, head of the chest division of the University of Oregon Medical School and head of the TB control program in Portland. Dr. Spero also said fear of radiation is doing harm to the tuberculosis finding program and to the community at large when he recently spoke before the Jackson County Public Health association. He said the fear has resulted from the surgeon general of the United States' recent announcement of the dangers of a mass X-ray program. He told the group that it is more important to continue the search for cases of active TB in the community, which is a more pressing danger to the health of the country than the small amount of radiation in safe proportions received from a chest X-ray. He added that the radiation from such an X-ray amounts to no more than that from a luminous wristwatch dial. Dr. Spero had made the trip
