"It's been three years since she filmed the last of her old series, 'I Married Joan.' Sometimes she sat quietly in her Bal-Air mansion waiting for the right property to come along.

"This is it," she says hopefully. "The first comedy-science fiction show in TV. The humor is based on situations involving me with actual scientific experiments."

Slapstick Helped Joan

"It may get a little rough on me physically, but I'm used to that from my slapstick experiences in the past.

"Space travel and Sputniks are in the news, and our show should appeal to all groups and sexes. Throughout the series I'll be accompanied by psychologists, anthropologists and the like, who record my reactions to different and challenging situations."

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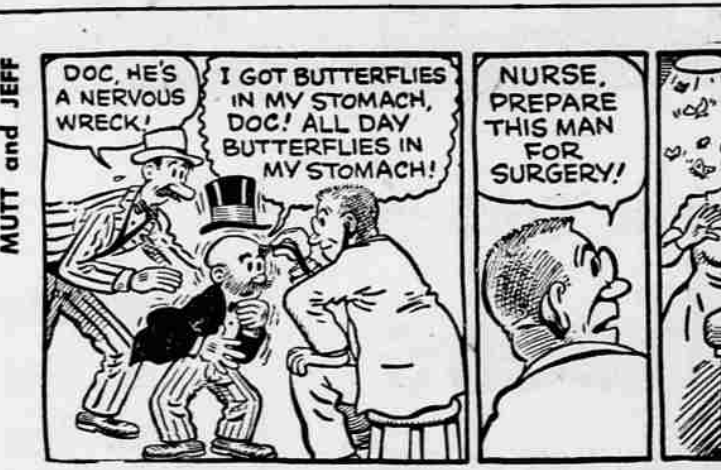
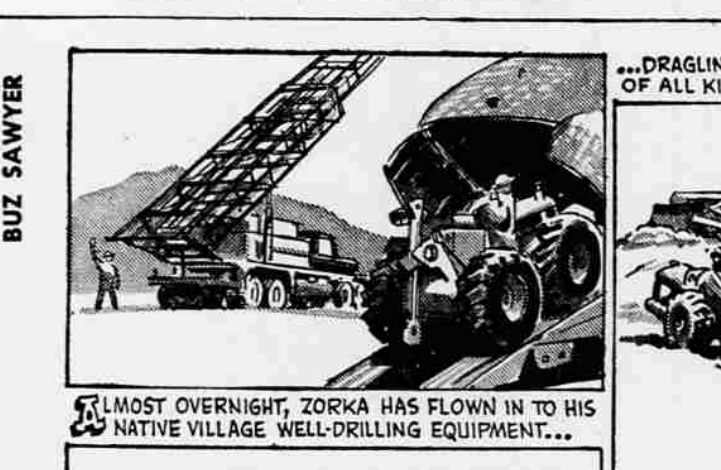
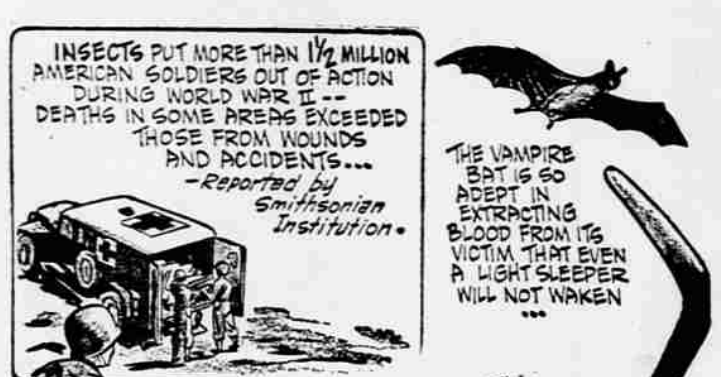
