NOTICE OF FILING APPLICATION FOR A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER

Notice is given that Walter B. Turner has filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Rogue River. The Supplemental findings of fact and order of determination of the State Engineer entered January 10, 1940, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights of the various claimants to the use of the water of Rogue River and its tributaries, determined the extent to which the inchoate water rights were completed in the Rogue River adjudication proceedings. In said findings the State Engineer found that Frances M. Ash had reclaimed and irrigated 1.5 acres in Lot 6 (SP-2NW1, Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., from Rogue River with a date of priority of 1906. These lands are irrigated through the Allen ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 2200 ft. N. and 920 ft. W. from the SE corner of Sec. 35, and being within NE 1/4 SE 1/4, said Sec. 35, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of 1.1 acre of the land above described, proposes to irrigate said lands by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said pumping plant to be located 1220 ft. S. and 5 ft. W. from the N 1/4 corner of Sec. 3, and being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, said Sec. 3, T. 34 S., R. 1 W., W.M.
