In a recent study at the University of Michigan, Nancy C. Moore and Robert S. Weiss found that 80 per cent of the men interviewed liked their job and did not wish to retire. As was to be expected, the more interesting the man's work, the less likely he is to want to retire. Skilled workers seldom want to retire, but about half of the unskilled workmen would cheerfully quit, if they only had enough money to live on. Many men who work for a salary have a hankering to go into business for themselves.

London — Ingrid Bergman left today by plane for Rome with her suitcase full of toys. She plans to spend Christmas with her children and Roberto Rossellini, the husband from whom she is legally separated.

The Christmas get together will be Ingrid's first meeting with Rossellini since their official parting. They agreed to spend Christmas together in Italy for the sake of the children.

"Most of the toys I bought in England," Ingrid said. "They are new to the children and they have such lovely toys here. I have two sets of toys for the twins so they won't get jealous."

Asked whether she and Rossellini will play Santa Claus for the children she laughed and said: "I'm sure we will. The children ought to believe in Father Christmas a bit but I don't really know whether they do or not. Anyway, they play along with us — maybe they're just acting."

PULITZER WINNER DIES

Pittsburgh — Ray Sprigle, 71, who won a Pulitzer Prize in 1938 for exposing then U. S. Supreme Court Justice Hugo Black as a member of the Ku Klux Klan, died here Sunday from injuries received in a traffic accident. In 1948, Sprigle, a Pittsburgh Post-Gazette writer, dyed his features and posed as a Negro to obtain information for a series of articles entitled "I was a Negro in the South for 30 Days."
