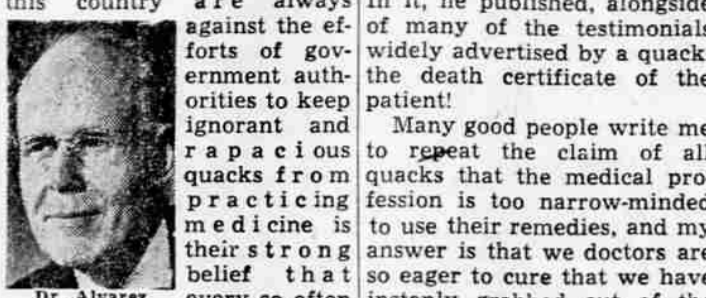

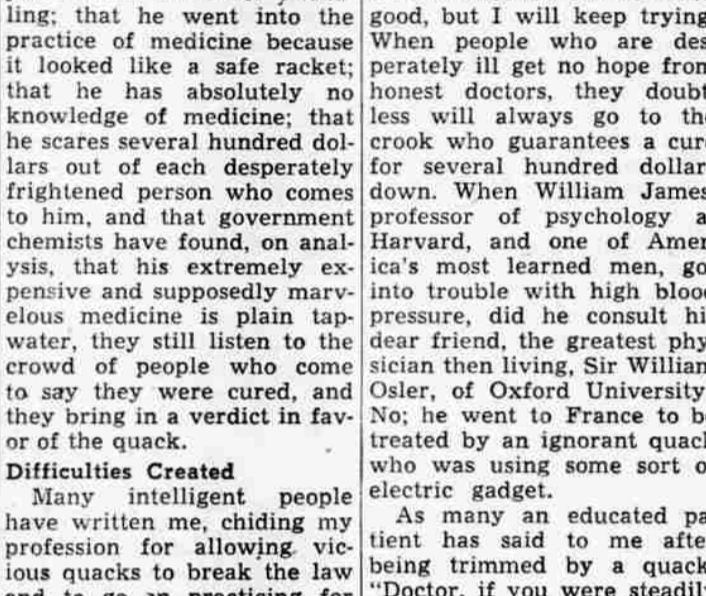

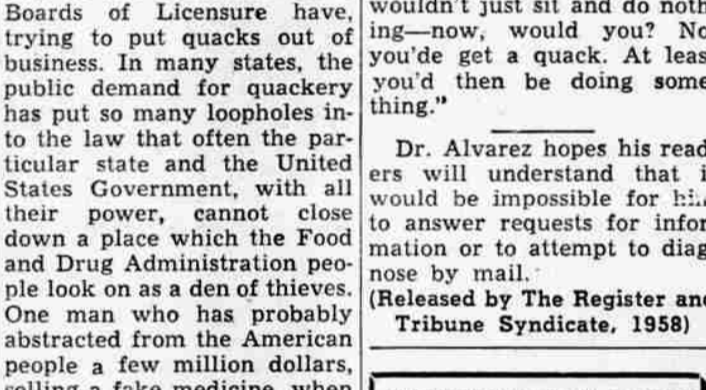

Salem—Oregon political news today saw the resignation of two state representatives. Guy Jonas, Salem Democrat, resigned to take a post with the state Insurance Commission.

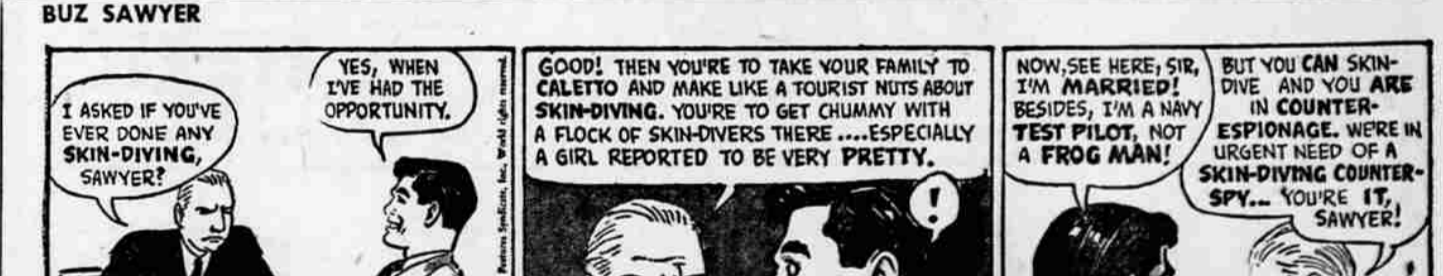
