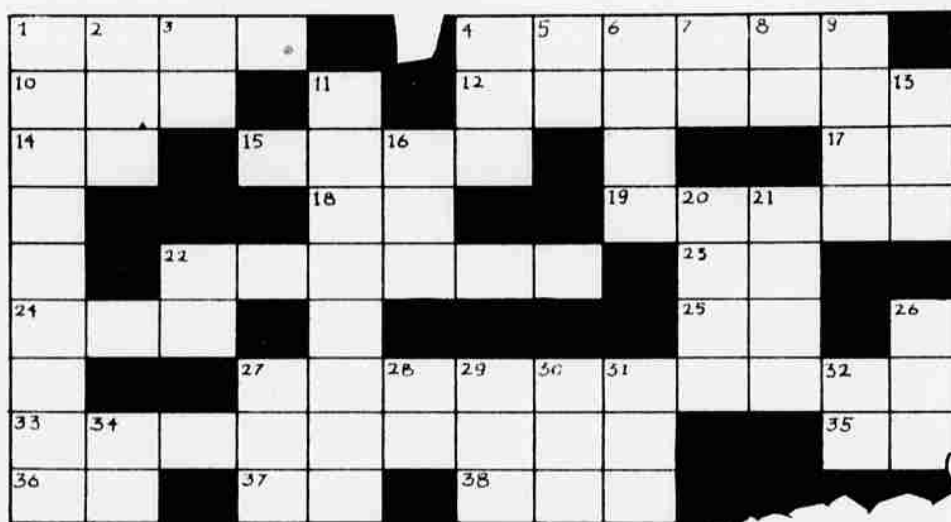
Grab the Tab
