Social Security Has Busy Year

A social security highlight of the year 1957 was a ceremony held June 6 recognizing the 10 millionth person getting monthly old-age and survivors insurance benefits, according to W. V. Nusbaum, district manager of the Medford social security office.

Last year was important in other ways, also, Nusbaum said. He pointed out that it was the first year in which social security monthly benefits went to people 50 years of age and older who were unable to work because of a severe and long-lasting disability.

More than 100,000 of these disabled people received their checks in the early part of August in payment for the month of July, the first month for which disability insurance checks could be paid.

For the first time last year, a severely disabled child of a worker who died insured under the law or who was himself getting old-age insurance payments, could draw benefit even if the child was more than 18.

The armed forces were first covered in 1957, and now more than nine out of 10 American working people have the protection of the law.

"At the end of 1957," Nusbaum pointed out, "the number of people drawing social security benefits was over 11,000,000."
