TRICHINOSIS

Trichinosis is a disease due to the eating of pork which has not been properly checked by inspectors in a slaughterhouse. Sometimes a farmer will kill a hog and will not notice that it has, in the muscles, little nodules each of which represents an encysted worm called a trichina. If such pork is thoroughly boiled or cooked that the little worm is killed, the eating of the meat should not do harm, but if the pork is not cooked well enough, those who eat it are likely to get into trouble, and rarely they can even die. Much depends on how many live worms they ate. For instance, a while ago a man became very ill because, while grinding some farm-killed pork to make sausage, he ate

Mrs. F. S. — Sue runs with an older crowd.
Sue S. — Mother is really shocked.

Mrs. F. S. — Should a girl of 19 run around with a crowd of girls ranging in age from about 22 to 27?

My daughter, Sue, who is all in that age group, she has been going around with them — on dates, to parties, on a vacation trip. I feel they are much too sophisticated for her. For one thing, they drink too much. For another, I'm afraid they're a bit too free in their conversation with and about men.

I'm not worried about Sue's doing anything wrong. I know she had the right upbringing and that I have nothing to fear on that score, but it just doesn't look right to other people.

Sue S. — Mother is such a prude. She always insists she doesn't worry about me and that she has no objection to moderate drinking and running around, but I know that in her heart she is really very shocked by these friends-of-mine.

I don't have to worry about what "other people" think because I know I'm doing nothing wrong and neither are these friends of mine. They are loads of fun and I have wonderful times with them.

As a matter of fact, these girls are so concerned about my welfare that they do not let me drink as much as they do. They call me "Baby" and really take care of me as if I were one.

In any case, it is not a good relationship for Sue, who ought to be going out with girls of her own age and men of an appropriate age. It would be a good idea if she changed jobs and got off to a fresh start socially.
