Hand Fashioned Coupe Entered in National Show by Local Man

Oakland, Calif.—A uniquely designed, hand fashioned semi-custom coupe has been entered by its builder, Jack Gault, 124 King st., Medford, in the National Roadster Show scheduled Feb. 15-23 at the Oakland Exposition building.

It will vie in display competitions for the gold trophy as best of its class in the 19 divisions of handmade autos, and will be in the judging for the nine-foot high gold trophy, largest in the world, for "America's most beautiful roadster of 1958."

Original, Hand Worked

Every car in the National must be original and hand worked by the individual, according to Mary L. Slonaker, only woman auto show manager in America. This is the only competition auto show in existence.

Gault's car carries several unique ideas, among them a refreshment bar built into the automobile.

Color motif for the Gault entry features a white and gold plated upholstery, with 25 coats of lime green lacquer on the body.

Five American makes are blended into the fancy Medford coupe, according to Gault. Based on a 1949 Ford club coupe chassis, the car has 1956 Oldsmobile styling on a

reworked front, 1956 Buick stripping, 1955 Chrysler tail lights and assorted stylings for rounded hood covers front and rear, bucket seats from an airplane refined for great comfort, and bumpers front and rear made of nerf bars.

The doors and deck lid covers have been rounded, the Medford man said. The hood is lowered. Rear fender wells are cut out.

Swifts Auto Club
Gault belongs to the Swifts Auto club of Medford, which likely will have a delegation making the long trek

down the coast to attend the show.

Last year four large groups of Pacific Northwest fans, one representing a Vancouver club, attended the show.

Floor plans have been laid out for the Exposition building which covers a full city block to accommodate the largest entry in the nine-year history of the National Roadster Show, the manager said.

Show hours will be 1 to 10 p.m. each Saturday and Sunday, including Washington's Birthday, and 6 to 10 p.m. on weekdays.

And our men in gray flannel suits don't like it one bit.

A prominent public relations executive has voiced the feelings of many of his colleagues by calling on the administration to come up with a "sound, hard-hitting program" to offset Soviet Russia's propaganda.

Madison Avenue Losing To Kremlin In Propaganda War

John W. Hill, chairman of the board of Hill and Knowlton, Inc., says it's a well-known fact that America is losing the propaganda war—even though we are spending more on propaganda than any nation in history.

"I agree with Secretary of State John Foster Dulles that

the Russians know how to employ all the invidious truths of propaganda—upside down words and phrases, alluring slogans and timing—and above all, they know how to take the offensive and keep us on the defensive," he added.

The Kremlin, he said, has a big advantage because after it decides on a policy, "it carries it out with no nonsense or delay. Here, there are too many people to consult, in government and among our allies. We must forge such a public relations program or resign ourselves to losing the cold war."

Hill, author of the recently published "Corporate Public Relations," suggests an immediate reappraisal of our propaganda efforts and a commission to do the reappraising.

Different Approach
"But I wouldn't put public relations men on the commission. This is a problem that can't be handled in a normal public relations way. I would put on the commission men, writers, other men who are public-spirited," he said.

"A sense of urgency should pervade this reappraisal," said Hill, "just as it now inspires our scientific, military and economic planning. This deserves the highest-level attention, just as much as our defense planning does."
