

Holmes, Agencies Briefed on Snake River Proposals

Salem—Gov. Robert D. Holmes and members of various state agencies were briefed Monday on the State Water Resources Board's recommendations for development of the Middle Snake river.

Seven possible combinations of public and private dams on the Middle Snake were studied by the board, including some not now being considered by the corps of engineers.

A combination using a high Hells Canyon dam ranked first in both power and flood control potential while the combination including low Hells Canyon, Oxbow, Brownlee and Low Pleasant Valley was ranked seventh in both power and flood control.

The board said their evaluation was tentative and based upon physical capabilities of the dams alone, without comparison of relative costs or existing licenses granted by the Federal Power Commission.

Board Congratulated

Gov. Holmes congratulated the board and its staff for turning out the Snake report with speed and within the \$20,000 budget. He said it would provide information of use for many years.

Don Lane, executive secretary of the board, said it would be necessary to go to the State Emergency Board for more money to continue its studies of the Rogue, Umpqua and Upper McKenzie rivers.

The board has requested the FPC to suspend immediately any part of the licenses for Oxbow, Hells Canyon and Brownlee dams that might interfere with maximum economic development of a high Pleasant Valley dam.

It also has recommended that the state defer action on the three Idaho Power company dams until the Corps of Engineers has revised its "308 report" on development of the Columbia river.

Five Teen-Agers Drown in Car Upset

Pocatello, Ida. — Five 16-year-old girls and boys drowned Monday night when the car in which they were riding plunged into the Snake river.

The mishap occurred while the teen-agers were returning home from a Latter Day Saints church young people's meeting.

Only the youthful driver escaped death.

The victims were identified as Gwenna Woodward, Verda Stone, Lamoni Webster, Mari-lee Smith and William Clark.

Investigating officers said the car was driven by Kim Sharp, 16. Sharp told officers the car hit a bump and its lights went out.

He said he lost control and the auto struck a series of guard posts on the river bank and plunged into about six feet of water.

FORMER NAZI SENTENCED

Heichingen, Germany — Former Nazi police officer George Mott, 57, has been sentenced to life at hard labor for murder and brutality at the slave labor camp he commanded during World War II. Mott was convicted Monday of beating Jewish and Italian laborers, ordering a 12-year-old Russian boy to be soaked with water and left to freeze to death, and being an accessory to the murder of a Jewish businessman.

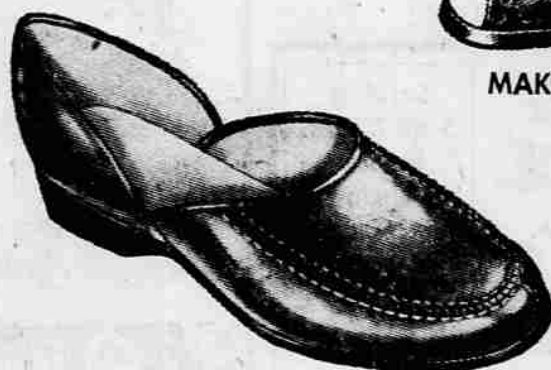
