Elderly Women With Poor Control Over Bladder

Many elderly women who have had several children and have been badly torn are often much distressed because, when they stand or sneeze or cough, they are likely to pass a little water. Often their womb comes down through the vagina, carrying with it the bladder and part of the rectal wall. What happened was that, when the woman was giving birth to a child, the muscles of her pelvic floor

got badly torn and were not immediately sewn together.

If such a woman is troubled enough and wants really to get well, and especially if she is going to live for another 20 or 30 years, she had better go to a good surgeon who will push her womb and bladder and rectum back into place and then build a new pelvic floor by sewing the ends of the torn muscles together again. If he can do a good enough job, the woman will be well.

Alopecia Areatia (Patchy Baldness)

Some people are much distressed because they have spots on their scalp, perhaps an inch or two across, in which the hair has come out and is not growing. About all the person can do is to go to a good skin specialist and see if there is anything he won't be able to do much, largely because he won't know why the person lost his hair.

Ted Husing Has Trouble Making Radio Comeback

Los Angeles — Ted Husing, dropped by Columbia Broadcasting System because of his "voice quality," has not given up in his efforts at a comeback and is ready to go back on the air whenever he can get a sponsor.

Sportscaster Tom Harmon, longtime friend of Husing, said today "you give us a sponsor and set a time and Ted will make the show."

Harmon agreed that the veteran radio sports announcer had been having some difficulty in recovering from surgery for a brain tumor that nearly blinded him and caused temporary paralysis.

"Ted has some difficulty in reading that makes his delivery not all that is looked for. However, it still is the same Husing voice of old and I have tapes recorded by him that prove it," Harmon said.

Undergoing Treatments

He said Husing is undergoing rehabilitation treatments several times each week at the Cedars of Lebanon hospital and that a new plan to aid his reading is being developed. Husing can read only large type and is unable to read newspapers or watch television.

A CBS spokesman in New York said Husing was reluctantly dropped Wednesday from his \$150-a-week contract because of the voice quality of test recordings. Husing is convalescing at the Pasadena, Calif., home of his mother.

The announcer won fame and popularity with CBS as a sports announcer from 1927 to 1946. He left sports to become a disc jockey. His return to CBS last August was his first job since his 1954 operation.
