Others had recently been dismissed from a mental hospital and still were not well enough adjusted to be driving. Many were the sort of persons who would ignore traffic regulations and would refuse to yield the right of way to anyone.

### What We Need First is a diagnosis.

What are the people like who are causing the accidents? Let us go with Dr. Alan Canty into the fine court in Detroit where, in recent years, the judge has been asking a corps of trained psychiatrists to tell him what is wrong with the man who keeps coming back again and again with a ticket for serious misbehavior on the road. The following sentence, taken from an address by Dr. Canty, tells us much about the cause of many of the 37,500 deaths a year. As he said, "In one instance, an examination was ordered for a commercial driver who had been ticketed on more than 200 occasions. His license had been suspended and he had been placed on probation, but he had continued to drive without a license."

### Examiner Not Qualified

As Dr. Canty said, much of the trouble starts when a man who should never be driving is granted a license. Obviously, in large cities the men who pass on an application for a license are not qualified to examine into the mental or moral or physical fitness of a man or woman. They have no way of knowing if he has just escaped from a prison or a mental hospital or if he is

## U. S. Officials To Urge Early Talk

Washington—High officials disclosed Saturday that President Eisenhower is planning to urge the Soviet Union to begin early diplomatic talks on disarmament and other issues as a possible prelude to an East-West Summit conference.

A letter outlining Mr. Eisenhower's views is expected to be sent to Russian Premier Nikolai Bulganin soon, probably next week.

North Atlantic treaty nations have been given a preview of the letter and were said to have approved it. Diplomats familiar with the frequent Eisenhower-Bulganin exchanges said the President's new message will be somewhat "testier" than his previous documents. The chief executive is understood to have been irritated by Russia's unbridled campaign against Secretary of State John Foster Dulles in whom he has full confidence.

The President also will firmly reiterate American insistence that preliminary negotiations "show good hope of advancing peace and justice" before he will agree to a Summit parley.

Officials said the first test of this would be the diplomatic contracts, primarily between U.S. Ambassador to Moscow Llewellyn E. Thompson, Jr. and the Russian foreign office.
