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Public Facility Financing Urged

Chicago — The United States Savings and Loan League has called on local municipalities to finance the construction of public facilities through long-term bond issues rather than by extracting "special concessions" from home builders.

The league, in a resolution passed at its 65th annual convention here, charged that such special concessions placed "unreasonable demands" on home builders, and in turn, on a relatively few home buyers.

"These demands," said the resolution, "have the immediate effect of increasing housing costs and prices, an thus retarding home building and buying."

Dangers In The Use Of Cortisone-Like Drugs

Many persons know today that it is unwise to take cortisone or a cortisone-like drug unless it is much needed for a rheumatoid arthritis or other serious disease. Then, the wise doctor will prescribe only the smallest dose that will make the pain bearable. He will not want to give enough so as to produce some unfortunate complication. What is hopeful is that there are many persons who are able to take small amounts of these drugs for long periods of time. I think they should do this only under the guidance of a skilled physician.

Tumors Of The Ovary. And Fibroids

Women want to know what is the difference between a tumor of the ovary and a fibroid of the womb. Usually a fibroid tumor is not a serious matter. It is just a lump of muscle on the womb, and it practically never turns into anything. Today, able gynecologists tell me they do not worry about a fibroid's turning into a cancer, because this happening is so very rare. They are much more anxious about a tumor of the ovary, especially in the case of a woman past 40 or 50. It might be cancerous when it is first found, and then if it should be neglected the woman might well lose her life. All I can say to people who have such tumors is, "Go to a good physician; get a good examination; if necessary get a consultation, and take the advice given you."
