TV Critic 'Fractured' by Victor Borge Performance

New York — Victor Borge, a gentleman who plays the piano and the buffoon, dropped into the cloistered halls of CBS-TV Wednesday night and unloistered them.

I must say at the start that Borge fractures me. If I have any bones to pick (careful, boy, those are fractured bones), it would be to complain that there wasn't enough Borge. I think some network should set aside a day to the man.

Enjoys Own Work

I suppose one of the reasons why I enjoy Borge so thoroughly is because he seems to enjoy his own work so thoroughly. He operates with a kind of maniacal gusto, a rapturous detachment from sense and reason. His world is nonsense, a nonsense compounded of equal parts of gloat and bliss and clouds, all of it smothered with a coating of imbecilic relish.

"I have two-and-a-half brothers," Borge said at one point during the evening. "Three half-and-brothers who make one-and-a-half and one regular one who makes it two-and-a-half. Incidentally, one of them is married to a very lovely girl, very wealthy—she owns a string of wishing wells."

Or: "I wish to thank my mother and father who made this show possible. And my five children who made it necessary."

Working on a Sandwich

I knew everything would turn out all right from the very start when Borge ap-

peared, surrounded by the gentlemen of the orchestra and a sea of Lawrence Welk bubbles. The orchestra was working on "The Liechtensteiner Polka" and Borge was working on a peanut butter sandwich and the piano. "This piano was made by Steinway and Sons this afternoon," he explained later. "Normally a piano has 88 keys, but this one has 89 because one of the sons is a little off."

He then went into a commercial for his auto sponsor and volunteered a recent picture of his own model. It turned out to be a mound of snow. "The bad thing about it, of course," shrugged Borge, "is that my wife is still in it."

And so it went. Borge slashed up some scores of Schubert and Strauss and Shostakovich and Debussy and announced he was composing a typical Tin Pan Alley hit. He opened two tiny plastic boxes for inspection. "They contain the first and last notes Mozart wrote," he declared solemnly.

Bambi Linn and Rod Alexander danced and Doretta Morrow sang and a 12-year-old Abbott Lee Ruskin, played the piano. Borge played some gushy Rachmaninoff and a medley of Gershwin, the latter punctured by remote shots of Broadway and Central Park South.

Strangely enough, the remotes showed the streets of Manhattan deserted. I guess everybody was in watching TV and I suspect they were watching Borge. At least I hope so.

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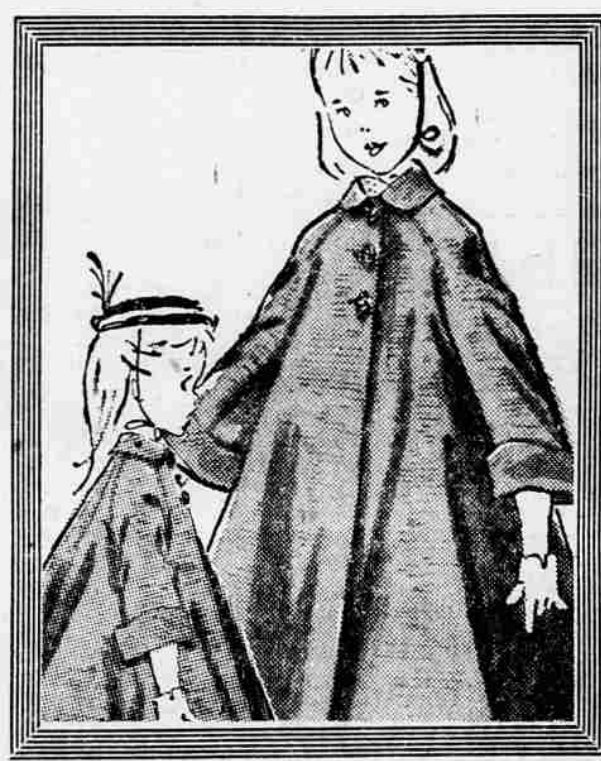
