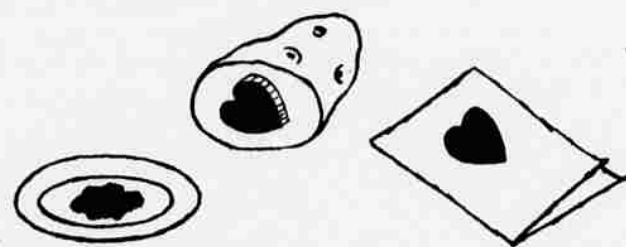

Potato Printer Walter Eckart

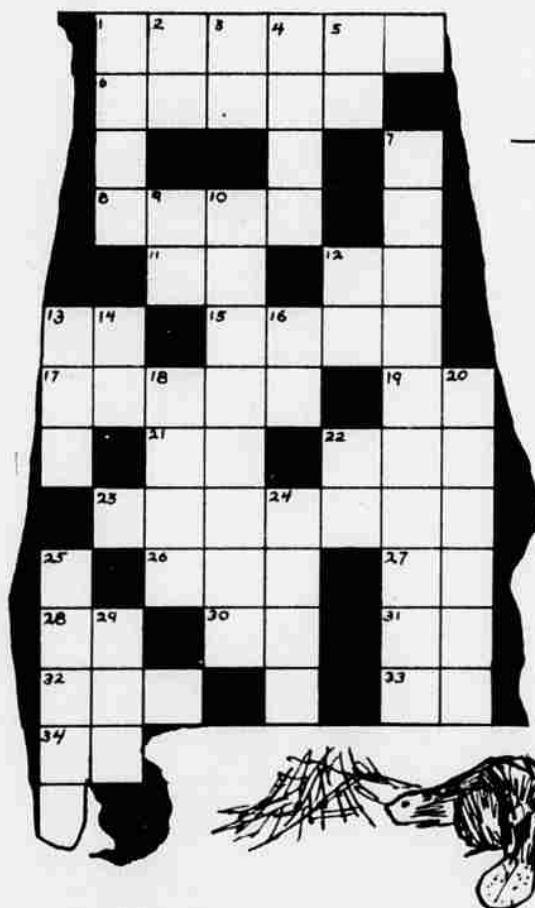
You can print a design with a potato! Cut a large potato in half and with an indelible pencil draw your design on the cut surface. Scoop away the potato around the design, so a raised pattern is left.

Dip this on a plate which has water color or diluted ink spread on it. Then press the potato onto a piece of paper to print your design.

We have used a heart shape in our drawings, but you can make any kind of design you wish.
