### Navy Would Drill At Teapot Dome

Washington — (AP) — The Navy hopes to get approval soon to resume drilling for oil on its extensive Wyoming Teapot Dome reserve for the first time in about 30 years.

A spokesman said Justice Department approval is being awaited so a contract can be signed with private oil operators to drill for petroleum for Navy use.

The reserve, set up in 1915, was last drilled by the Mammoth Oil company in the 1920s, and was the subject of an oil scandal during the Harding administration. It is now believed to hold some 10 to 12 million barrels of petroleum.
