

Japanese Scientists Await Sun Eclipse

Tokyo—Japanese scientists hoped today for clear weather Saturday for effective observation of the 80 to 90 per cent annular eclipse of the sun.

The eclipse will start about 11 a.m. in Japan and last for about three and a half hours.

The Tokyo Astronomical Observatory and Seismological Institute sent observation parties to Hachioji island, 180 miles south of Tokyo.

Darkness will envelop Hachioji island for about six minutes. A ball game between the Hanshin Tigers and the Chunichi Dragons at Nagoya has been delayed half an hour because of the eclipse.
