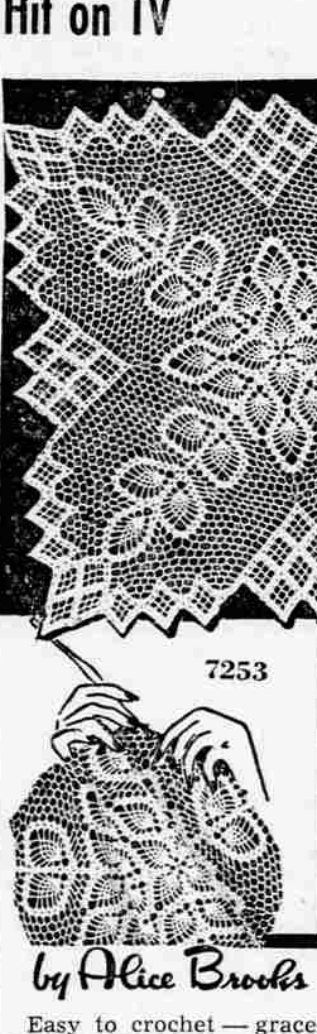

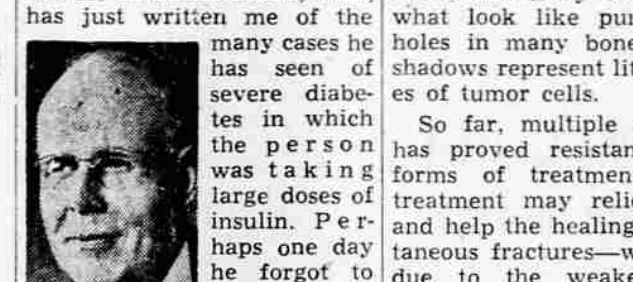

The Diabetic With a Severe Insulin Reaction

My old friend, Dr. Edgar A. Hanz, of Grand Forks, N.D., has just written me of the



many cases he has seen of severe diabetes in which the person was taking large doses of insulin. Perhaps one day he forgot to eat enough food to balance the big dose of insulin, and, as a result, he went into a woody state in which he didn't know what he was doing, and worse yet, didn't realize the danger he was in. In several of these cases the man got in his car and drove wildly until he had an accident, and in several such cases the person was killed. All persons with severe diabetes who are taking large doses of insulin should remember that when they are not feeling perfectly well they should not be driving a car.

Incidentally, there are many other people nowadays who, when taking a large dose of some powerful antidiabetic, or some strongly sedative medicine should not be driving. The results of going to sleep at the wheel can be tragic.

A few unhappy people write, asking what is multiple myeloma, and is there any new treatment for it. I am sorry to have an answer that multiple myeloma is something like a scattered cancer which affects many of the bones of the body. Usually, it attacks persons past middle age, and it produces pain, anemia, and weight loss.
