

## Mental Health Week Gets Recognition In Jackson County

Mental Health Week, being observed nationally from April 27 to May 3, is also receiving recognition in Jackson county. Several of the service clubs are making some presentation of it either during this week or at some other time in the near future.

The Child Guidance Clinic association plans to present two films that show the normal development of younger children. One is entitled, "The Terrible Twos and the Trusting Threes", the other "The Frustrating Fours and the Fascinating Fives". They will be shown during the week in both Medford and Ashland.

**Committee To Meet**  
Friday noon there will be a meeting of the Mental Health committee of Jackson county in the conference room of the Health unit at the court house. Dr. Harry Danielson will present a plan for the establishment of a limited family counseling service on a trial or demonstration basis.

The Mental Health committee is an informal group which tries to coordinate com-

munity efforts on behalf of mental health and cooperate with the Mental Health association of Oregon in support of the state mental hospitals. The committee made the studies and enlisted the community support leading to the establishment of the Child Guidance Clinic, in 1953. The committee recently has been studying ways in which family counseling service might be provided for the county.

### To Name Officers

New officers of the Mental Health committee will also be chosen at the Friday meeting. The retiring chairman is the Rev. Thomas McCamant. Miss Celia Walker is the secretary. In the 4½ years of its existence the Child Guidance Clinic has become one of the principal agencies on behalf of the mental health of the community. It is a psychiatric clinic in which emotionally maladjusted children and their parents are afforded the joint services of a psychiatrist, psychologist and psychiatric social worker.
